

May Term 1808

Whereas I John Elliot of the County of Randolph State of North Carolina being weak of body but of sound mind & memory do think proper this twentieth day of February in the year one thousand eight hundred and eight to make the following distribution of such property that I am blest with & first my will is that all my just debts be paid as soon as may be.

And to my wife I give one half of personal Estate the whole to be equally divided between her and my son James Elliot after my debts are paid.

I give my son James all my lands to him his heirs forever leaving to my wife a sufficient living on the place while she remains my widow. And lastly I hereby appoint my friend Enos Blair and Robert Mason my Executors in Pitconny whereof I have heretofore set my hand and signed my last the day and year above written.

Be it remembered that I Abraham Elliott son of Randolph County and State of North Carolina this twentieth day of December one thousand eight hundred and seven being weak of body but of perfect mind and memory blessed be God and knowing that I am appointed for all men one to die I do make and ordain this my last will & Testament and as touching such worldly estate as it hath pleased God to bestow upon me in this life I give and Dispose of in the following manner first I ordain and constitute Samuel Elliott and Sarah Elliott my wife to be my only Executors of this my last will & Testament I allow my funeral charges and just debts to be paid out of my estate. Then I give and bequeath unto my three sons Joseph and Abraham and Enock Elliott five shillings a piece and to my three daughters Priscilla Easter and Lavinia five shillings a piece I then give and bequeath unto my loving wife Sarah Elliott the balance of my estate to live and dispose of as she sees fit in withstanding whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal the day and year above written.
