Whereas I John Robins Esq. of the State of North Carolina Randolph County in the Year of our Lord One thousand Eight hundred and Twenty Seven May the 22nd Being sick and on the decline of body and sound mind and memory do recollect that it is appointed for all men to die, do make this my last Will and Testament, first of all things I Will my Body to the Earth to be buried in a decent and Christian burial and all Funeral Charges paid, and my Spirit to God that gave it, and as for the small Estate that it hath, please God to bless me with, first of all things I Will of my Estate sufficient portion to pay all my just debts, then first of my Land I Will to my Grandson John Robins Warren Robins fifty Acres of Land lying as follows, beginning at the house White Oak Jenkins Run, thence running East so far as to include the improvement where John Robins died, thence North for complement and the remains of my land I Will to my two younger Sons, namely Elias and Michael Robins to be equally divided between the two, Elias on the North, Michael on the South it is to be divided by an East and West like direction, so as to give Michael all my Newbuildings and I give to my Daughter Elizabeth Robins the privilege of staying and making it her home while single, but not to marry Michael, and for my small Estate Personal, my Will is it to be sold and my just debts paid and the balance to be divided between Christopher, Michael and Elizabeth, excepting all the rest of my Children is to have one Dollar a piece

I also give and bequeath to my Son William fifty five Dollars and the rest of my property equally divided between them all, after my debts are paid, I also hereby appoint my Wife Margaret and my Son William sole Executors of this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking all former Wills by me made, in Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 20th day of April in the Year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and Twenty Seven.
