the mortality of my body and that it is appointed for
me once to die I do make and ordain this my last will and
Testament in manner following and as touching such worldly
Estate as it has pleased the Lord to bless me with I Bequeath
Give devise and dispose in the following manner I ordain and
Constitute my son William Washburn and my son Isaac William
Washburn to be my whole and sole Executors and trustees of this my
last will and Testament first I allow my funeral Charges and
just debts to first paid out of my Estate - I give and
Bequeath to my beloved wife Rebecca Washburn a bed and furniture
and a chest and half portion and Jewels furnished and her
Maintenance on my plantation during her natural life
Then I give to my daughter Ann McMillen five Shillings
I give to my son Thomas Washburn five Shillings
I give to my son Joseph Washburn five Shillings
I give to my son Benjamin Washburn five Shillings
I give to my daughter Mary Washburn five Shillings
I give to my son William Washburn ten pounds I give to my son
five Shillings I give to my daughter Rebecca Washburn
Shillings I give to my daughter Elizabeth Washburn five
six shillings and six pence and my best best robe - and put
back and half my Jewels furniture portion and other things and
decease I allow my land to be sold and the remaining part of my
