 son Edward to be the mother a sufficient
 maintenance during the time of her life with them
 but if she should think it best to move (to move)
 & live with some of the rest of the family

It is my will that my son Edward shall
continue to give a sufficient support
for her, finally all the rest of my property
both in doors & out, upon the plantation I
give to my son Edward Chamney in witness
whereof I have Joseph Chamney here to the

and all the land that I am lawfully possessed of for her

constitute and appoint my loving son Joseph Arledge
and my worthy friend Joseph Vestal my Executors
