

Wanted - Secondly my Will & desire is that my beloved wife Rachel Newby have & Enjoy the plantation & improvements thereon & also live during her natural life also I give & bequeath to the said wife one horse saddle & bridle one Cow & calf one feather bed, bedstead & furniture provision of all kind sufficient for her maintenance for one year one Saw & Axe one flint whet one Powder Duke one pot, one Dish oven one Tub one pail one Paper two smooth stone twelve Cornish plates one Set of Tea cups & saucers one Can of Knives & for her by Row & one Coffee mill to her & her heirs for ever - Thirdly my Will & desire further is that after the death of my said wife Rachel be mentioned herein before to her for life be sold to the best possible advantage by my Executor & the money arising from such sale to be equally divided between all my children that shall then be living & the legal heirs or Representatives of each of my children as shall have previously died - Fourthly I give & bequeath to my apprentice boy David Bowman in consideration of his uniform good conduct & faithful services one breeding Mare - Fifthly my Will & desire is that all the Test & Residue of my Estate of what nature or kind soever, whether Real or personal not herein specifically named be sold by my Executor & the money arising from such sale to be equally divided amongst all my children or their legal Representatives then & there alive - Lastly I do here by these Words nominate & appoint my truly friends & neighbors Henry Tate Executor of this my last Will & Testament - Signed sealed Published pronounced & declared by the aforesaid Samuel Newby Senior to be his last Will & Testament in our presence who we
