in one year next after my decease also my son John
Campbell shall pay to his Brother Daniel Campbell
Fifteen pounds Silver in one year next after my decease
also I give to my Son John Campbell my half Duff
also I give to my loving Brother Alexander Campbell
Fifteen pounds Silver to be paid by my Executor in one
year of my Decease also I give to my Daughter Catherine
Kathy ten pounds Silver also I give to my Daughter
Margaret Anderson ten pounds Silver also I give to
my son Malcom Campbell my Bed & I make and
soil in my son Malcom's early bed my Job Lacunets of
this my Will I have for the Interests and Profits in this
my will and Contained in witness thereof I the said
Saughlin Campbell have to this my last will and
Testament Set my Hand and Seal the Day and Year

till it crosses the mouth of a brook named Creek running
there past a South Course till it crosses the back bound
then to continue the same course to the limit of the
said Boundary of land 2 1/2 acres of ground and Bequeath to my
1st Son John one of my wagons I also Bequeath to my
