 my Daughters. to maintain them their lifetimes but if my Daughter
 Elizabeth Remove off the land then to have more Right there I do Will and
 Bequeath that after my Daughter Elizabeth Beavers that I do give this land
 Wharson I do now live to my grand son Lewis Beavers to him his heirs and assigns
 forever

Then I do Will and Bequeath to my grand son Lewis Pennington a certain Red
 Deer. three year Old this next Spring to him his heirs and assigns forever
 Then I do Will and Bequeath to my grand Daughter Rachel Beavers one
 Hundred Calf to her and her heirs I and assigns forever.

of John Land and Ruth the Wife of Stephen Beavers and my Son David Land and

them and their heirs I do hereby nominate constitute and appoint my Daughter

Elizabeth with my Son in law John Land and Stephen Beavers Executors

of this my last Will and Testament hereby Enjoining and Requiring all
