Lewis Morgan.

In the name of God Amen! I Lewis Morgan
of the County of Stokes, & State of North Carolina Being sick & minded
through my last mind & memory Thank be to God for his grace. And also in
mind to mind the mortality of my body knowing that it is appointed for
all men once to die. I do make this my last Will & Testament & I
give & recommend my soul to the hands of the Almighty God. I give
to devise & dispose of in the following manner & form.

I give & bequeath to my beloved wife Anne Morgan a certain
white horse & a half of the herd.

I give & bequeath to my beloved daughter Rachel Morgan a joy
steed & a feather bed for her to enjoy & fully Doff.

Also I give & bequeath to my beloved son, John Morgan a certain bed of
said Gray Horse, at Christmas Also a saddle & bridle, with two
very wearing apparel therfor him fully to enjoy & keep.

I hereby disallow & revoke all & every other former Testiment, Will
& Legacie, Bequest, & Devotion by me in any way before aforesaid
discreated. Ratifying & confirming this no other to be my last
Will & Testament. In witness whereof, I have hereunto set my
hand and seal this ninth day of June, in the year of our
Lord 1801. — signed.

In the name of God Amen I Samuel Parkes In the County of Randolph
& living through the abundant mercy and goodness of God
being now to mind that it is appointed for all men to die do consti-
tute this my last will and testament And annex it to be recorded
by me at this and touching such worldly estate wherewith it has
pleased God to bless me with in this present life I give
leave and dispose of the same in manner and form following
First. I bind my wife Parkes my wife form term of life that
one of part of the tract of land I purchased of John Kimbrough
where on I now live lying east of the Meadow Branch And
part of the Spring branch I except three acres of land where the
true house and other buildings stand there stand I also land
many fine Negroes named — one Negro Lucy Little & Lucy
for reason & so is for her good conduct and that a Negro
I give to the heirs of Elizabeth Morgan twelve shillings of
fine peasant money

I give to my daughter Lucy I was born Negroe named
Elizabeth Morgan Name & Chapman

I give to my daughter Sarah Morgan three Negroe
named Eliza Hannah & India and also five hundred
pounds current money

I give to my daughter Sarah Campbell two tracts of
land lying in Union County one held by states and
known by the name of Gilbert place the other
held by me from his son in that place. I give to
Sarah three Negroe named Capt Lewis and
Jacob and also five hundred pounds current
money in

I give to my son Solomon Parkes that part of the tract
of land I purchased of John Kimbrough that I did not
leave money my wife and other tracts againing one held
by my self and William Parkes one other tract held by
me I purchased at publick Vendue confiscated property
of Henry Pitts W.M. Cook two tracts held by me and from
William Little one other tract held by and given to his son George
