Copy of his last Will & Testament of
In the Name of God Amen! I Lewis Morgan
of the County of Stokes, & State of North Carolina, Being sick, weak, &
though in perfect mind & memory, thank be to God for his mercies, do hereby
testify to record the mortality of my Body, knowing that it is appointed for
all men once to die. I do make this my last Will & Testament, & I
give & recommend my soul to the hands of the Almighty God, & as
I desire, I dispose of in the following manner & form.

1st I give & bequeath to my beloved Wife Ann Morgan, a natural born
State the Maiden hold for a time that is not measurable, & also a white cow
& five Shatts. And one half of the barn.

2^d I give & bequeath to my beloved Daughter Rachel Morgan, a grey
cow, & a Feather Bed, for her to enjoy & fully possess.

Also I give & bequeath to my beloved son John Morgan, a certain batch
of said Gray Hens, at Christmas. Also, a pair of black Oxen, working
to my wearing apparel, this for him fully to enjoy & possess.

I do hereby disavow, & revoke all & every other former Testament, Will
Legacies, Bequests, & Bequests, by me in any way before a made, &
disavowed. Ratifying, & confirming this & no other, to be my
last & Testament. In witness whereof, I have hereunto set my
hand and seal, this ninth day of June, in the year of our

Copy of the last will and testament of Samuel Parker
In the Name of God Amen I Samuel Parker In the County of Randolph
being through the abundant mercy and goodness of God
becoming to mind that it is appointed for all men to die do hereby
testify this my last will and testament And desire it to be received
by all as such and teaching such words as follow, which with me has
pleased God to bless me with in this present life I have
revised and disposed of the same in manner and form following
First. I had to say Parker my wife for term of life the
one of part of the tract of land I purchased of John Trim brought
whereon I now live being east of the Meadows Branch And
North of the Spring branch I except three acres of land where the
house and other buildings stand to the said land. I also land
many five Negroes named — I have to say Long, Lilly, & Rony
for reason I do so is for her good conduct and kind usage
I gave to the hire of Elizabeth Morgan the sum of
five pounds, current money.

I give to my daughter Mary I once four Negroes named
Viter, Mowah, Nance & Chapman
I give to my daughter Gineal Harper three negroes
named Mingo, Hannah & Jude. And also five hundred
pounds current money
I give to my daughter Sarah Campbell two tracts of
land lying in Bowen County one held by States dead
known by the name of Guillen, place the other
held by her from her son in Abt. I give to
Sarah three Negroes named Rapt, Lewis and
Lucas And also five hundred pounds current
money

I give to my son Solomon Parker that part of the tract
of land I purchased of John Trim brought that I did not
send money my wife and other debts against one held
by and from William Pickett one other tract held by
and I purchased at public Vendue confiscated property
of Henry Little one other tract held by and from John Little
William Little one other tract held by and from John Little
