That is to say

first After all my just debts and funeral charges be settled I give and bequeath to my beloved daughter Bathsheba Foster one cambric gown and one silk handkerchief with 2 Bathsheba being in Guilford County and State of Virginia

Secondly I give and bequeath to Thomas Thornbrough Senr of Randolph County all the remainder of my estate of all and every description whatever to receive and hold forever after my decease

And I appoint and ordain my worthy friend Thomas Thornbrough Senr of Randolph County and State of Virginia my executor to this my last will and testament
