In the Name of God amen I Mary
Barton being sick of Body but of sound
Mind & Memory do make & declare this my Last
Will & Testament. In manner following
First I Give & Bequeath my Soul to God that gave
it & my Body ready to be taken from whence it
is & taking of this Bequest that all my true
debts be paid, & the remainder of my Estate to be
divided as follows— First I Give & Bequeath
to my daughter Eliza one dollar, and I
Give & Bequeath to my son John one dollar,
and I Give & Bequeath & Bequeath to my son
William one dollar & unto I Give & Bequeath
to my son James one share of Land to begin at
his house and I abate him down the Spring
branch and run south ten poles to Jacks house
thence East with his line & extend on East corner
clear a crop the old plantation to the East
Side of the old ~~land~~ plantation tract and to
hold all the Land within them boundaries also one
pole two small pasture Barrens four pasture
plots I do hereby state my old chest my old
bed one Table one half of my stock of sheep
all my stock of Hogs Except one Sow & Pig
one Cow & half one Lamb & one
I Give & Bequeath to my daughter
Elizabetta the balance of my Land where
the end of the road lives in the same

eleven or twelve my horse & then stays one
 big kettle one small pot one sand one one
 I killed the pulch birds & two Peter Parson
 & half a bag of split peas two split broads two
 I eat the birds & what had black. The wheat proper
 one chest one sack of Tallow two boxes & one small
 I give one half of my stock of sheep one cow
 & pigs one big wheel one wheel I appoint my two
 sons John & William Patterson sole Executors
 to the my last will & testament in witness whereof
 I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal
 the eighth day of June in the year of our Lord
 one thousand eight hundred & eighteen

 Esburn Superna Reynolds five Shillings each
 I give & bequeath to my beloved wife one bed
 bedstead & furniture during Life and then to be
 the property of my son Edward I also allow my
 son Edward to be the mother a sufficient
 maintenance during the time of her life with them
 but if she should think it best to move (to move)
 & live with some of the rest of the family
