 give him, one Kettle & one Iron Stove the Re-
 mainder of my Pots, tubs & one Iron Stove all which
 Property I will and bequeath to him his heirs &
 assigns forever and I do further devise and direct
 that all and any of my Property should be as
 recommended by the foregoing Items that it shall
 be equally divided between the said Knicker

 give him, one Kettle and one Iron Stewpot the Re-
 mainder of my Pails, tubs and one Iron wheel all which
 Property I will and bequeath to him his heirs &
 assigns forever and I do further bequeath and direct
 that all and any of my Property should be an
 considered by the foregoing items that it shall
 be Equally divided between the said Kindee
 Dawson & John Powell Share & Share

 Alexander Gray Executor of the my last Will &
