in State of North Carolina being of sound & perfect mind  
do hereby make this my last will & testament in  
my own hand & seal following  
First it is my will ever since that all my Goods and Furnishings  
Shall be paid and set to such persons as I am bound by  
Law & such shall it shall be divided as follows  
Viz Firsty I will & bequeath to my son Nathl Davis  
and wife Elizabeth and wife wife 2 pair of Horse  
I give with my Horse & Harness one Black mare &  
the same must sell which she is now in Foul with  
Two Cows & calves. Two sheep, two huds of my  
Hogs. Two of my best Birds. Bedchairs & Furniture  
of every description the Room to be left to her  
one Bedding. Table one candle Stand and Candle  
half a Doz Glass one Pearl one large looking glass  
3 large Welsh Dishes. half a Doz small white Plates  
half a Doz of large & half a Doz small plates  
a Doz Spoons. half Doz knives & Forks one large  
Flouring Coffe Pot. half a Doz cups & saucers  
Two Pitchers and Quart decanter one Beautiful  
One Big Pot & one even, my Loom Knapping Bars  
Quill Wheel and all the Tools belonging  
to the Loom and Lining frame & one Doz Heddles  
one Potash Two good Water Pails one Washing  
Pail one Butter Churn & my best Glass Wheel Two  
Lace and Spooling Box one Lyth & Cradle one  
Iron tooth Baker one Island & Large pair of  
Smoothing Irons, one candle stick with a large  
Red Crowned one can to store Kettles two

Small Skillet one Coffee Mill one Negro Woman  
 named Ann & her Child Eliza and also a Negro  
 Girl named Zilda All Which Property I give and  
 Bequeath to him his heirs and assigns for ever upon  
 Condition that he said Kindle Dawson leave  
 my unto the Administrators of my late Husband  
 Daniel Dawson two hundred Dollars or there  
 over to him the sum of two hundred Dollars as may be  
 owing to the said Estate over the part to which  
 I am entitled by Law, and also on his paying to my  
 son John Powell Two hundred Dollars or there  
 over to him the sum of two hundred Dollars which if  
 this may not be feasible to him to do. I hereby  
 I will bequeath unto my son John Powell my  
 Servt Rose, Two Sheep, Three Sheep are this.  
 Part of my Stock of Hogs Two hundred Dollars  
 I direct that one Small Table one Bedstead  
 Two Chairs and my bedding Furniture not above seven  
 hundred Dollars for him to pay to my son John Powell  
 one bedstead Two hundred Dollars or one Large Skillet  
 one Pot Cook Two hundred Dollars in Money to be  
 paid him by my son Kindle as my Negro girl  
 Zilda which was my son Kindle which property to  
 give him, one Kister & one Iron Hatchet the remain-  
 der of my Pots, Pans & one Plan which all shall  
 property I will and bequeath to him his heirs &  
 assigns forever and I further beseech and desire  
 that he leave any of my property mentioned herein  
 be divided by the foregoing items that it shall  
 be equally divided between the said Kindle  
 Dawson & John Powell Slave & Slave

Zilda Which Eva my son Hinckle thinks proper to  
give him, One Thuler & one Iron Shovel the Rem-  
ainder of my Pots, Pots & one Iron Ware all which  
Property I leave and bequeath to him his heirs &  
assigns for ever and I do further desire and direct  
that in case any of my Property shall remain  
unclaimed by the foregoing items that it shall  
be equally divided between the said Hinckle  
Dawson & John Powell Slave & Slave
