said Edward Clark one Negro Woman twenty two years old and her young child
and both above fifteen years old to have and to hold all and singular
the said Negroes and every of them by these presents granted bargain
sold and release granted and confirmed unto the said proper wife & child
of the said Edward Clark in Heirloom Administration and Assigns forever &
I the said Richard Whitehead for my self my Executors and Administrators
all and singular the said Negroes unto the said Edward Clark his heirs
administrators and Assigns against me the said Richard Whitehead
my Executors Administrators or Assigns and against all and every
other person and persons whatsoever shall & will warrant and forever
Defend by these presents in Witness I have hereunto set my hand
and seal the twenty eighth day of April 1792

Know all men by these presents that I Simon Green High Sheriff of Randolph County
in the State of North Carolina for & in consideration of the sum of one hundred & thirty
pounds to me in hand paid by William Field of the County of & State aforesaid the
said Simon Green Sheriff by Virtue of his Office aforesaid and by Virtue of a writ
of the said Simon Green Sheriff from the Clerk of the County of Orange commanding
him that of the good North Carolina & Government of North Carolina
he cause to be made the sum of one hundred and twenty seven
pounds seven shillings and 9 the further sum of two pence
Eighteen shillings and 9 the cost of suit having Date the 15th Day
of June 1792 and in the sixteenth year of American Independence
Independence and that the said Sheriff have the said money before
the Justices of the said Court to be held for the County of
Orange the for the money in August in the same year there
and there to Render to Governor his Damages and the said Simon
Green High Sheriff by Virtue of his Office and pursuant
of the aforesaid writ of Simon Green as also by force of
the Act of assembly by in such laws made and provided did
by the said writ on four negro and sundry other property
said to be the property of Aaron Hill and having perused
the same at the Court House of Randolph and being
situated within said County ten days previous to day of
said he the said Simon Green on the 30th Day of June 1792
did expose to sale by way of public auction
in his and open sale and charged the aforesaid negroes
named Aaron Binga slave for the Conservation of one
hundred and fifty pounds Current Money of State of North
Carolina in hand paid by the said William Field he
being the highest bidder the receipt where of is hereby
acknowledged to the said Simon Green he has granted and
sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell
unto the said William Field the aforesaid negro man named
Arter or at least all the little little entry claims or
Demand whatsoever which in the said Aaron Hill name
had or ought to have had of in and to the said negro
unto him the said William Field his heirs and assigns
to have and to hold the said negro or at least all the
little little property claims and Demand whatsoever
which he the said Aaron Hill name had or ought to
have had of in and to the said negro unto him the said
William Field to the only proper use Benefit and behalf
of him the said William Field his heirs and assigns for ever
In witness whereof the said Simon Green High Sheriff of the said
County of Randolph hath hereunto set his hand and
Seal the 21st Day of August 1792
