as to my worldly estate I will and positively desire  
that all my debts be paid first bequeath to Elleroy  
Sidney one bed & pate and furniture and to my daughter  
before and as for my other goods and land I bequeath  
each of my children an equal share of the same  
Charles Mullin Lewis Sidney John Gray John Bryan Burns  
John McCollum and to my grand daughter Margaret Guru  
I bequeath five Shillings Sterling & Do constitute John  
Gray my son in law and Elleroy my daughter Executrix  
of this my last will and Testament and trustee for  
my other children in North Wales I have unto God my  
hand and seal this 22 Day of April in the year of our  
Lord 1804.

On the 22nd Day of April 1804 I Edward Guru  
of the County of Randolph being English and make in body sub of perfect  
mind and memory thank be given unto god therefore taking to mind  
the mortality of my body and knowing well it is appointed for all men  
one to die Do make and Ordain this my last will and Testament  
that is to say principally and partly of all I give and command my  
soul into the hands of Almighty God that after its end my body  
recommend'd to the earth to be buried in Earthly burial at the  
direction of my Executor nothing hindering but at the general resurrection  
I shall receive the same again by the mighty power of God and as  
honoring such worldly estate wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me  
in this life I give away and dispose of the same in the following  
manner and form -

To my will and devise is that my Son Frederick Guru who  
have the plantation of One hundred acres of land and he is to  
maintain his father and mother during their lives and he is to have  
the third of the estate and the rest of my estate is to be equally divided  
amongst the heirs as follows Namely Adam Guru Bradford Guru  
Peter & Amos & Frederick Chapman & one thousand George Guru James  
Somerset also to my Son Robert I give one hundred acres of land and his  
share part of the land he paying twenty one pounds to the Executor  
one equal part with the rest of the aforesaid land by himself  
he held and enjoyed Benjamin Clark and Edmund Guru  
I likewise constitute make and Ordain my sole Executors of this  
my last will and Testament this and no other to be my last  
will and Testament in witness whereof I have unto God my hand  
and Seal this day and year above written
