 two hundred acres of Land on the Waters of Blacat
 and the Mill place and the Needham Place to my son
 John & living on the same Water, to my son
 Richard I give three hundred acres of Land lying on
 Cedar Creek Chatham County to James Beattell.
 I give two hundred acres of Land lying on the
 Waters of Deer River in Alcorn County I also give
 to my son Richard two hundred and thirty seven
 acres of Land lying in Alcorn County in deep run
 and to my son Daughter Nancy - Elizabeth Little
 son, Henry, Rosanna, Rhendema & Rachel to my
 each of them I give five shillings a piece, to my three
 grand children Namely George & Anna Frazier &
 Richard Pearson five shillings a piece, and to my son
 James children I give five shillings a piece to my
 Beloved wife Elizabeth the place now live on until
 my cash & cash notes and all my property that
 have been mentioned herein during her life time
 or widow hood if she incline to alter her situation
 by Marriage - then I give to her one Feather Bed
 and furnished with her wearing cloths

at the end of my wife life time or widow hood I give to
 my Grand son Ezra Deason the above said property
 if there be any left to be sold and Equally divided
 amongst all my children if there shall be any
 left at the end of her life time or widowhood to be
 Equally divided amongst all my children

 and full of all I give & recommend my soul

into the hands of almighty God that gave it and my
Body I recommend the earth to be buried in decent
Christian Burial, at the discretion of my Executors nothing
doubting but at the general Resurrection I shall receive
the same again by the mighty power of God, and
receiving such worldly Estate wherewith it has pleased
God to bless me with in this life I give devise and bequeath
of the same in the following manner, and Terms—

First that all my Just Debts be paid, all Debts owing
in properly tested that they might be paid without any
Limit taken of the Law. I give to my Beloved
wife Elizabeth Black one Cow half her Bed & Cha-
-ing and the living of my Child in her Widowhood
also the use of my House while in her Widowhood
if she wants to live there—

- 2nd I give to John Black John Black Robert Black Thomas Black
these I have present of as much as I was able—
- 3rd I give to John Black one Cow of Dray—
- 4th I give to General Madhew Gallaher thirty dollars out of my estate
- 5th I give to Joseph Black I give him his horse and Purcell on
the New Testament and this plantation on which I
now live on and the rest of my Books to be
Equally divided among my Children—
- 6th I give to Joseph Black my son one Cow also—
- 7th I leave Lewis Morgan Black to the Discretion of my
Executors that he is well done by and give him
something. 8th I leave give to Jonathan Walker his
clothing & tools—
- 9th I give to Mary Walker her Bed & Bedding—

I hereby make and declare my last Single Black &
John Joseph Executor of this my last will and Testament
in witness whereof I the said Samuel Black have written
my last Will & Testament set my hand and seal this
