

February Term 1818

- Whereas I Samuel Silliker of Randolph State of N. Carolina Calling to mind the Uncertainty of Time here do think proper this 12<sup>th</sup> day of the Grand Month 1817 to make the following Distribution of my little property - and test my will is that all my said test be paid,
- 1<sup>st</sup> I give to my son William two hundred acres of Land known by the Name of the Old place where I once lived near the Warburton Meeting House
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> I give to the Heirs of my son John three Acres & a half or more One hundred Acres of Land lying in the State of Ohio on Whetstone Creek the Heirs of the Heirs also One hundred Dollars in Money to be divided equally among them when the youngest Child arrives to the age of Twenty One years
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> I give to my son Benjamin Sixty acres of Land adjoining to the Lands of Joshua Holliday Frank Lytle & others Generally known by the name of the name my son Benjamin having already received a Settlement two hundred acres of Land as part of his share
  - 4<sup>th</sup> I give to my son John the Title I have on Elmore Rails for the Tract of Land I purchased of John C. Sledge amounting to Four hundred & seventy five Dollars also One hundred Dollars in Money
  - 5<sup>th</sup> I give to my son Samuel the Tract of Land where I now live for the support of my poor wife during her widowhood and to her heirs forever

- 6<sup>th</sup> I give to my Boy Abraham by offer the Tract of Land I purchased of William Ferguson known by the Name of the Ferguson place provided that if the said Abraham shall die without an Heir of his Body that then the said Tract of Land shall be sold as other Lands as hereafter directed
- 7<sup>th</sup> all my other Land I desire my Executors to sell and also the last mentioned tract in Case said Abraham shall die without an Heir of his Body - and that my Executors make Title to the purchasers and the Money arising from said Land and all other or other Land I desire may be Equally divided Between my Widow and said Children now living Son and Daughters as they hereafter shall be named
- 8<sup>th</sup> I also give to my son Samuel all the live Stock and Farming Utensils and One half of the House hold Furniture and the other half of the household Furniture I give to my Widow and at the End of her Widowhood to be equally divided Between my five Daughters
- 9<sup>th</sup> I give to my Girl Popham as she is now called
- 10<sup>th</sup> It is my will that my part of the Negro called to me by Thomas Lytle be sold or sold on the Land where said Lytle died but provided the Heirs of said Negro cannot be obtained I hereby give them to the Humane Society in Pittsburgh - Reserving out of said Lytle Estate a sufficient Sum to satisfy and pay for all expenses and Trouble which said Negro & Lytle said Lytle Estate

and lastly I hereby appoint my Widdow Benjamin  
and my son Samuel & Benjamin my Executors -  
declaring this and no other to be my last will &  
Testaments in witness whereof I have hereunto set  
my hand Seal the day & year above written.

time of my Dissolution and that he take me to himself  
into that peace and Rest and Eternal Fellowship which  
he has prepared for all that love his holy Name Amen  
Blessed be God I give my Body to the Earth from  
whence it was taken in full assurance of its Resurrection  
from thence at the last day as for my Soul I desire  
it may be dealt with piously in State at the  
Discretion of my dear wife and my Executors hereafter  
named who I desire not will manage it with  
all arguments prudence as to my worldly Estate I will  
and expressly Order that all my Debts be paid
