First of all I Will and bequeath that all my just debts and Expenses chargeable shall be paid out of my Estate. Then I Will and bequeath unto my Daughter Dennisine Charity Pittings - Item I Will and bequeath unto my Servt Lou Britton Twenty Pittings - Item I Will and bequeath unto my beloved wife Mary all my Lands and property in Doos and out Doos that I do happen to have and to hold during her life time or her widowhood and at her decease or marriage to be equally divided among the rest of my Offspring the Two Boys to have the same. Wiley and I give and Will to have One hundred and twenty five Acres of the other land by running a strait line North and South and up to have the rest of my Land the Girls to have an equal part of the rest of my property Nancy Penman and Elizabeth - Item I further Will and bequeath that Dugan Clark and my beloved wife Mary shall be my sole Executrix to this my last Will and Testament to settle my worldly affairs as the Law directs in Witness whereof I have counterset my hand and affix my Seal this 30th day of December 1821.
