In the name of God Amen I Stephen Lewis of the County of Randolph in the State of North Carolina, planter, being sick and weak in body but of sound disposing mind & memory desire to give and bequeath that it is appropiate for all men once to make their own last will and Testament and that it is the Privilege and first of all Men to make my last will and Testament and that my body & the land I do bequeath in a brief manner at the desire of my Executors hereafter named, and in Testimony hereunto I have signed these my last will and Testament with my hand and in this last of John Daye and Thomas a. and it hath pleased God to bless me with in this last of John Daye and Thomas a. and the following manner and form, To wit, It is my will that all my last will and Testament I give and bequeath to my Son Stephen Lewis the plantation land & bequeath that I bought of Thomas Eagle containing two hundred Acres of land to be possessed by him and his heirs & assigns forever
Then I give and bequeath to my Son David Lewis the plantation land and bequeath that I bought of Thomas Eagle containing about one hundred & fifty Acres of land in Randolph County to be possessed by him and his heirs & assigns forever
Then I give and bequeath to my Son Books Lewis the plantation whereon I now live in Randolph County containing two hundred Acres of land to be possessed by him & his heirs and assigns forever.
Then I give and bequeath to Successor my loved wife my last mentioned plantation with all my movable & fixed Goods & Chattels both in person and without as long as she remains my Widow for the bringing up of my Children Except what is hereafter mentioned.
Then I give and bequeath to my two Daughters Phoebe and Elizabeth each of them respectively \$200 the said two pounds to be paid over by my
