In the Name of God Amen I Thomas Cox of the County of Randolph State of North Carolina being old and some what weak in health but of sound & perfect mind and disposing memory do ordain & make this my last will & testament in manner as follows Viz After Resigning my body to the dust and my soul to him who gave it. It is my will and desire that I should be decently buried in a Christian like manner. My funeral charges & last will to be paid out of my Estate & the balance of my Estate to go in manner as follows. First I give & bequeath to Elizabeth Cox my wife two horse & a bay mare & all two cows and calves her choice & after for a buck five hogs and five head of sheep and all my furniture and household furniture at her disposal one horse & one mule and one cow & one mare on the 1st of Nov. for ever to her and her heirs forever. 2<sup>d</sup> I give & bequeath to the heirs of my son Stephen Cox five shillings to him & his heirs forever. 3<sup>d</sup> I give & bequeath to the heirs of my son Thomas Cox five shillings to him and his heirs forever. 4<sup>th</sup> I give & bequeath to the heirs of my daughter Martha Williams Mary's name Elizabeth and Lucy five shillings to him and his heirs forever. 5<sup>th</sup> I give and bequeath to my daughter Elizabeth Garner five shillings to her and her heirs forever. 6<sup>th</sup> I give and bequeath to my son John Cox five shillings to him and his heirs forever. 7<sup>th</sup> I give and bequeath to my daughter Jane Barker five shillings to her and her heirs forever. 8<sup>th</sup> I give and bequeath to my son Adam Cox one note of hand given payable to me by my son Thomas Cox for thirty five dollars and Adam a third of the 10<sup>th</sup> note also a bill of Jacob Williams for eleven dollars and ten cents to be paid to him by my son Jacob Cox making in all fifty five dollars & that to be his full share of my Estate to him and his heirs forever. 9<sup>th</sup> I give & bequeath to my daughter Rachel Cox one cow & calf and one horse & mare to be her choice & her maid her to my son John Cox to her and her heirs forever. 10<sup>th</sup> I give and bequeath to my daughter Edmonson one horse saddle & bridle one cow & calf and one flat wheel to her and her heirs forever. 11<sup>th</sup> I give & bequeath unto my son Jacob Cox all my land and plantation whereon I now live containing 250 acres more or less only reserving the use of the same to my wife Elizabeth Cox for her support & maintenance of herself & family for & during her widowhood and after that to him and his heirs forever also one cow & mare and one cow and calf one hog and one pig one horse & mare one mule and one mare and five chickens & her heirs forever. 12<sup>th</sup> I give and bequeath to my grand son Adam M. Williams one hundred acres of land on the East side of Spurred Creek when he arrives to the age of twenty one years provided he behave himself and serve his grand Mother and family faithfully until he arrives to the age of twenty one years and if he die before he arrives to the age of twenty one years the said one hundred acres to be sold and equally divided between my wife Elizabeth Cox Jacob Cox Rachel & Edmonson. It is my will and desire that all the residue of my Estate not here before given away to
