In the Name of God I leave to my wife, Isabel Davis my Slave and Servant and hold her for her life time or widowhood when she and her are gone with it. I do then divide and come into the hands of my four sons according as it is herein written, the East part of the Land to my two eldest Sons, John and William, from the head of Thomas Morgan Spring Branch down the Branch to the Fence running West with the Fence to the house of the Farm running then North with the Fence towards Thorsboroughs Farm, then running East to my Creek by the big Road, this with my Negroes I give and bequeath to John and William. 3rd I give I give and bequeath the West part of my Land to the Meadow Branch. 4th to David I give and bequeath the Dwelling House and Land behind the two Branches and the Bofat and Clock the Meadow to my four Sons as long as each one continues to do his part in keeping it up. 5th I bequeath my Daughters, I give and bequeath to her one Horn Cattle, one Cow, one Bull. 6th I give and bequeath one Horse Cattle one Cow, one Bull. 7th I leave my Girls no Land, but to pay each of my Girls five Dollars, William to pay each Girl five Dollars, Alfreda to pay my two Girls five Dollars

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a piece, being to pay each of my Daughters ten Dollars a piece. I also leave to my Executors and managers of my Will and Estate let no person or persons break this Will - my Son and my Grandson, witness in November the 10th 1826.
