I give and bequeath unto my Son William Davidson the other half of my land lying South of the
aforesaid James containing by computation one hundred & twenty acres be the same more or less with
the satisfaction of him & his heirs forever, he paying out of the same to his Executors when
two parts of ten shilling and Eight pence English Money and to his two other Sons, James & William
and one the like share of two hundred American Money & four hundred English Money.
I give unto my Daughters Lydia & Sarah & their heirs forever, and the same part each
of what all the remainder of my Estate shall be sold at publick Sale by any Executors and the money
in the payment of my debt & little for to be Equally divided between all my Children above and
at which time my Son Davidson Lydia & Sarah James Davidson Mary & Son James & William
and son. All I do hereby nominate constitute & appoint to execute my last will and Testament who I have
named Executors and Joseph & James my Executors of this my last will & Testament who I have
named with the payment of my debt & little & charges according to the true intent and meaning hereof
