In the name of god Amen. I Timothy buda
of Randolph County & State of North Carolina,
being in a poor state of health, but of perfect
mind & memory thanks be to god for it, calling
to mind the mortality of the body & knowing that
it is appointed for all men once to die, and
touching such worldly estate as it hath been
pleased god to bless me with - I give & dispose
of the same in manner & form herein after mentioned
hereby revoking & disannulling all former will and
testaments by me made, allowing & confirming
this to be my last will & testament principally
& first of all I recommend my soul into the hands
of Almighty god who gave it & my body to the
earth to be buried at the discretion of my friends

I give & bequeath to Liddy my well beloved
Wife all my household goods & farming utensils &
all my stock of cattle, hogs, hays & sheep except
one cow & calf & one feather bed & bedding -

I then, I give to my daughter Mary Lane fifteen
shillings - I then, I give to my son William
the sum of fifteen shillings -

I then I give to my Daughter Isabel Garner
the sum of fifteen shillings -

I then I give to my son John the sum of
fifteen shillings -

I then, I give to my Daughter Ann Garner the
sum of fifteen shillings. I then, I give to my
Daughter Elizabeth Murry the sum of fifteen
shillings. I then, I give to my son Timothy
the sum of fifteen shillings. I then, I give
to my Daughter Liddy Buson the sum of
fifteen shillings. I then I give to my Daughter
Sydney one feather bed & bedding & one
cow & calf -

I then, I give to my son James the plantation
whereon I now live containing one hundred
acres, reserving to my aforesaid wife one
third part of the spring tract of land
during her natural life - I appoint my
wife & my son James Executors of this my
last will & testament, signed, sealed, pub-
lished, & pronounced by the said Timothy
buda as for his last will & testament this
third day of April 1806 in
