In the Month of April arrived John Thompson of the State of North Carolina. Remained in city during May which was spent in body but of perfect mind & memory. He said he is glad to call on & converse with any body but knowing that it is an affliction for all men here to die, do make and sustain this my last day & sustain my soul into the hands of Almighty God that gives it and my body I recommended to the Father to be buried in a decent Christian Burial at the direction of my Executors and a body such worldly State where-with it shall please God to bless me in this life I have devised & disposed of in the following manner & form

Item. I give to William Thompson Senr. and to Mary Thompson
 and to James Thompson Senr. all the land that I now hold on
 both sides of Second Creek, that they may divide it equally
 among themselves after my death. I send E. J. give to Joseph
 and Robert Thompson, and to James Thompson Senr. and to William
 Thompson Senr. and to Mary Thompson & to William Thompson
 Senr. & to James Thompson Senr. all the money that I have in my
 hands and all the notes that can be collected. that is due to me
 at the present time to be divided equally amongst them all
 after my decease — also I give unto my living friends and
 to my Wife & money which I sit, debts and I give unto them their
 share in the same equal with the rest. For love to mine is not enough
 to make it up, I give unto Mary, Betsy & William — also
 I give unto Betsy being the best, both which I got from Mary
 Thompson, & also I desired that my household furniture may
 be divided among them at the discretion of my Executors, and
 it is my last will that if any disputes and quarrels the proper
 of the above mentioned persons, without force, or fear that delay
 according to the laws of Great Britain, or for that delay
 and settlement, I also constitute John and William as sole
 Executors to this my last will and settlement ratifying and
 confirming this and no other — William Thompson Senr.
