In the Name of God Amen I William Matthews of  
the County of Randolph & State of North Carolina being in  
a low state of health but in perfect mind & memory do make  
& appoint this to be my last will & Testament First of  
all I command my soul to God my body to the Earth  
Ground Next that all my just debts to be paid & then remainder  
part of my estate I give in manner & form as following  
First I give to son Thomas Matthews a certain piece or  
parcel of land which he now has in his possession beginning at  
Moffitts line at the branch running a strait bound to the  
fork of Branch a bare Moffitts field thence along  
Branch to the line then south round to the beginning -  
Next I give to my son Edward Matthews a certain piece  
or parcel of land which he now has in his possession  
beginning at a black Jack corner on Rains line near  
the old path running east to the branch thence  
down the branch to his corner - Also one hundred  
& ten acres which he now lives on in Chatham County  
and shall set by Discrewing Twenty Dollars -  
Next I give to my son William Matthews the balance  
of my lands in Chatham County -  
Next I give my son Egbert Matthews the balance of  
the old tract in Randolph except a piece in the fork  
of the branch adjoining Rains my son is for my  
use till me & my daughter Ruth have their dwelling  
& support her on the plantation as usual with  
Egbert during their life or widowhood

Next I give to my daughter Mary Farmer one dollar  
Next I give to my daughter Elizabeth Edwards one dollar  
Next I give to my daughter Hannah Edwards one dollar  
Next I give to my daughter Esther McDonald one dollar  
Next I give to my daughter Ruth Kirby one dollar  
Next I give the balance of my estate real & personal  
to my wife & family that remains on the plantation  
for a support - Lastly I appoint my son Thomas  
Matthews & my son William Matthews as Executors to  
this my last will & Testament In witness whereof  
I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 15<sup>th</sup> day  
of November one thousand eight hundred & eleven
