Be it remembered that I William Watkins of the County of Randolph & State of North Carolina being in a weak state of health but in his perfect mind & memory do make this my last will & Testament being in mind to dispose of all my worldly affairs

I then first of all I will & bequeath that all my debts & several charges should be paid out of my estate then I will & bequeath unto my beloved wife Lydia all my moveable property that I have & possess during her life time or widowhood & at her death or marriage the property to be equally divided between my child then named & wit. Henry William Watkins, John Lydia, Joseph B. & Benjamin C.

I then I will & bequeath that my beloved wife Lydia Watkins & Henry William should be my sole executor to this my last will & Testament to have care and management of my worldly affairs in the said County of Randolph during I have health to let my hand & affix my seal this 13th day of September 1816
