In the Name of God Amen I William Swann of the County of Randolph and State of North Carolina being of Sound Mind and Memory do this the 15th day of October in the Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty two do make and publish this my last Will and Testament in the manner following (Viz) First that all my last debts be paid and then I give and bequeath unto my beloved Wife Elizabeth all that and three part of the part of Land I now live on including the Dwelling House and an House to be laid off for her use in convenience as she shall think fit for her to hold and peacefully enjoy during her Natural life time or Widowhood. I also give to my Wife Elizabeth her and her heirs forever all the property she brought with her at her Marriage also one Horse Saddle valued at Sixty Dollars, and two Horses, two Cows and furniture, two Cows and a Calf, two Head of Sheep and all the Wheat and Proper Cereals, two Head of Hogs, two Spinning Wheels, Proper and Good Bed, two Smoking Half doz of Chairs, one Box, one Saw, one Washing Tub, two Smoking Irons, together with her personal Property, and one Year provisions out of the Coop on hand. I William Swann also Will and bequeath unto my two Sons, John and William all that and three part of the part of Land I give to my Wife to be divided in such a manner that John is to have thirty seven more than William, and each and part to be equally incumbered with the Widow's Dowry, and at her Marriage or death the
