In the name of God Amen I Mary Angelica Roberts of the State of North Carolina and Rockingham County, being of sound mind and memory, though weak of Body, do make and ordain this instrument of writing to be my last will and testament revoking all others

That To my dearly beloved son John Roberts I give and bequeath one new feather Bed and furniture, and bedstead, one chest, one small trunk, and all my wearing apparel to him, his heirs & assigns for ever

That To my Niece Lucinda Roberts daughter of my Sister Elizabeth Roberts, her heirs and assigns for ever, I give and bequeath ten Dollars in money, provided, that the same can be safely conveyed and applied to her particular use and I hereby strictly enjoin it on my Executor herein after named to this clause of my Will shall be executed with fidelity, provided nevertheless that in case my said Executor shall not have it in his power to convey the said legacy of ten Dollars to the said Lucinda so that it shall be applied to her particular use and benefit prior to my said son John's becoming of lawful age that then and in that case it shall go to my said son John his heirs and assigns for ever

That Immediately after my decease my will and desire is that the whole of the balance of my Estate consisting of Cattle, household and kitchen furniture &c. shall be sold by my said Executor to the highest bidder at public auction on twelve months credit and the moneys arising from such sale or sales
