George Chadwell came
before us John Odineal
& Thomas Slarig two of the acting Justices of the
peace for said County and made oath that previous
to the death of his Brother William Chadwell
he was present and was asked apart to take notice
that he wished his property disposed of in the
following manner his negro woman daries this
child named he gave to his neeether Mary Deay
during her life after her death to be Equally
divided between Mary & Elizabeth Deay his half

sisters, he also gave to each of his half Brothers
Thomas Garland & Samuel Deay and gave horse a piece
the residus of his property to be Equally divided between
his own Brothers George Valliant David & John
Chadwell after paying all my last debts -
he also requested that his Brother George Chadwell
should act as Executor of this his will and the
property divided as above stated. John S. Wright
also maketh oath that he was present and heard
the aforesaid William Chadwell make the above
disposal of his property

In the name of god amen I Alexander Brown
of the County of Rockingham and State of
North Carolina being weak of Body but of sound
mind and memory thank god for the same but
calling to mind the mortality of my body and
knowing that it is doomed for all men and
to die do this tenth day of May in the year
of our lord 1815 one thousand Eight hundred and
fifteen make and publish this my last will and
Testament in manner and form following that
is to say
the first I give to my grand son Alfred Brown a certain
piece or parcel of land to be taken off of my old
tract beginning at the line of N.D. Murrays and
the Spring Branch thence down said Branch to
it inuaders to Murrays line and all on the south

124 of the same quantity not known
Thus the 2^d. the Balance of all my lands I give to my
beloved wife Elizabeth Brown to dispose of as she
may see cause I also give her all my stock of
cattle and all my stock of hogs and all my
stock of sheep and one Bay mare known by
the name of the paddy mare bridled and saddled
and two Bed. and furniture all of which she is
to dispose of as she may think proper
Thus the 3^d. I give to my grandson Alfred Brown
one gray horse known by the name of the
dean horse and saddle also one hoe and an
axe and one Mattock

Thus the 4th. I give to my grandson Alexander
Brown one Bay horse known by the name
of the booley horse also one hoe and an
axe and one Mattock

Thus the 5th If the negro slave Bob is redeemed my
wife is also to have the disposal of him also
my Just debts is to be paid out of the money
due me by my Executors and I make and
ordain my worthy friend Thomas Law an
Executor to this my last will and Testament
In witness whereof I the said Alexander Brown
have to this my last will and Testament set
my hand and seal the day and year above written

State of North Carolina being of sound mind and memory do hereby
make constitute & ordain this my last will and Testament in form
and manner following to my wife E. B. I give during her life or
widowhood one Bed and furniture one horse saddled
two cows all my farming utensils with table & kitchen furniture
and sufficiency of corn and other provision to support her & family
one year likewise one negro woman call^d denah to attend and her
during her life and her choice of any tract of land I am in possession
of to reside on during life or widowhood without any limitation
from those it may be devised to in this my said will and if
the same may not be sufficient to support her comfortably she
is fully authorized by these presents to draw annually what may
agreeably as above mentioned from my said estate to my son
Alfred I give his creature and saddle and the tract of land I now
have on with an set of Blacksmiths Tools and one Bed and
furniture with one negro Bay call^d peter all which he is to possess
of immediately at my death except the land which his mother may
make the choice of her residence as above mentioned to my son
Geo. B. I give and bequeath the tract of land or so much thereof
which I purchased from David Owen and a part of a tract on
which Walker Thomas now lives as is here designated to be laid
off in the following manner (to wit) Beginning at Abel
Martins corner on the North Bank of penny creek at a
white oak mark^d 1.M. & S.B. running North and said line to the
Owen corner thence on his line North to the corner and so on said
line agreeable to the corner laid down in said Owen deed until
it strikes the said penny creek again above the Mills dam thence
down the said dam taking all the dry land without striking
between the house David Owen last in and the mill dam
thence running so as to include the spring thence to a fork
post oak Walker Thomas former corner thence on said line to the
creek & down said creek to the beginning with the house
in which said Owen lives formerly lived which he is to
have immediate possession of at my death but not to
sell unless approved of by my Executors untill of age but
all rents & profits to go to the use of his Education untill
he has fully completed his Education in the English &
Latin Language & a good understanding of Science and
kind One bed & Bedstead & furniture and Diet & fifty dollars
out of my estate for the purchasing of clothes and
as he may need and one negro Boy call^d called J.C.
