In the name of God Amen
 I Alexander Martin Esq. of the
 County of Rockingham in the
 State of North Carolina late Governor
 of the same, calling to mind the Uncer-
 tainty of Life and that all mankind
 sooner or later must die have thought
 proper, now being of sound and disposing
 mind and memory to make this my
 last will and testament.

First, I order and direct that all my just
 debts be paid out of what crops I may
 have on hand and out of the crops
 of the succeeding year for which purpose
 all my hands will be kept together
 under oversiers for said year without
 division my stock of cattle horses & hogs
 will be also sold except what are herein
 reserved— my funeral expences to be
 discharged from the above, which I order
 to be liberal not ostentatious at the discretion
 of my Executor herein after named—
 Having several tracts of lands in different
 parts of the state which I have not devised
 I wish them sold and the monies arising
 from said sales to be equally divided between
 my Brothers James, Robert, Martha Rogers
 and Jane Henderson my Sisters and I

hereby empower my executor to make title to
 the same in fee simple— These lands lie tract
 of 300 acres in the County of Montgomery 200
 in the County of Anson— 400 in the County
 of Rowan 650 in partnership with Col^d W^d
 Osborn in Buncombe County, 400 in wilkes on
 the tip of the ground farther mountains
 within 12 miles of gen Lenoir— however should
 any debts remain unpaid from the first proviso
 I order the sum to be paid out of the sales aris-
 ing from the above lands—

Then I bequeath and devise my Danbing plantation
 where I now live to the use of my Brother in
 law Thomas Henderson, and his wife Anna Jane
 Henderson my Sister for and during their natural
 lives each, on this condition that they maintain
 and support my Mother Jane Martin in as decent
 and proper a manner with regard to clothing
 and provisions as she has been accustomed to have
 during her residence with me— and to enjoy and
 have the use of her own chamber, bed and furniture
 for and during her natural life— and should
 the said Thomas and Jane or either of them
 die before my said Mother she is to have the like
 support from their successors herein after named
 and after her the death of the said Thomas
 and Jane— I give bequeath and devise the
 said Danbing plantation including and
 embracing therewith the new grant between
 pleasant Henderson and Robert Martin
 adjacent thereto, comprehending upwards of
 seven hundred acres— to my nephew James
 Martin jun^r son of James— to hold to him
 his heirs & assigns forever I also give him
 my negro boy Cudjo son of Baam to him &

his heirs and assigns forever. —
Item I give and bequeath to the use of my Mother
aforesaid for and during her natural life, my
man prince and Negro woman There with
her husband Billy to aid the said Thomas
Henderson and Jane his wife in the support
and maintainance of my said mother —
after the death of my said mother my will
and pleasure is that my said servant prince
be set free by order of the County Court or general
assembly for the many faithful & meritorious
services the said prince hath rendered
me in my life time. — and the said
Thene and Billy her husband I give to my
sister Martha Rogers to her her heirs and
assigns forever. — and also give her son
commonly called Jonny Miller her son
brigit her daughter Beck & increase together
with Thene Branis daughter & her increase
to hold to her her heirs and assigns for ever
Item I give and bequeath to Thomas Henderson and
Jane his wife my man Sancho peg her
children Ben and Charity with her future
increase Bet and her present children to
the said Thomas Henderson and Jane his
wife In and during their natural lives
each afterwards the same are to be equally
divided or the same disposed of to his children
as the said Thomas Henderson and Jane
his wife should think proper in their life
time to order to them their heirs and
assigns for ever. — I also give to the said
Thomas Henderson & Jane his wife my girl
nanny prince's daughter to hold to him &
his heirs under the restriction of the
first negroes bequeathed to him —
Item I give and bequeath to my Brother
James my man Brum and my blacksmith

Iack to him his heirs and assigns forever
together with my gold watch & seal my
horseman's sword and my case of pistols
to him his heirs and assigns for ever. —
Item I give and devise to the use of my Brother
Robert Martin the land adjacent to the eastward
of the Danbing plantation to wit two hundred
acres called Wharides place and phil gates tract
of ninety six acres on cookes creek — and also the
following negroes to wit Hor or princi's princi's
son, Billy Jesse grandson and my negro girl
messey to hold for and during his natural life
afterwards I give and bequeath the said land &
part of said negroes that is to say to on or
primus and Billy Jesse grandson. aforesaid
to his natural son Robert Irennem otherwise
called Robert Marton Turner to him his heirs
and assigns for ever and the said negro girl
messey after the death of said Robert Marton
Senr. I give and bequeath to Sarah Drannan
natural daughter of the said Robert Martin
otherwise called Sarah Martin to her her heirs
and assigns forever. —
Item I give and bequeath to Major Pleasant
Henderson and half of my prewit track
of land near Duck river to be divided in
quality and quantity to hold to him & his heirs
and assigns for ever. — also one negro man
named Lewis to hold to him his heirs and
assigns for ever. —
Item I give and bequeath to my nephew Alexander
M. Rogers five hundred acres being one fourth
of my Duck river land together with
my negro boy called Brampton of Bram to
hold to him his heirs and assigns for ever. —
Item I give and bequeath to Thomas Turley the
residue of the said duck River land
being five hundred acres together with
a negro Boy called anthony to hold to him
his heirs and assigns for ever. —

Item I give, bequeath and devise to my natural Son Alexander Strong son of Elizabeth Strong otherwise called and known by the name Alexander Strong Martin my Quarter lands called Ralston on Jacobs Creek containing eight hundred acres comprehending therewith two preceptants and the purchase from Birly and wife also Grist Mill and the part of Land therewith said to be forty acres together with the part of Land joining called Roberts Mill tract. —

also four hundred and fifty acres part of my Harpeth Land in the state of Tennessee to include William Allen's Improvement and to be laid off in a square, so as not to injure the revenue of said tract to be herein after divided among other Legatees. — to hold all such tracts of Land to him his heirs and assigns forever. — I also give to the said Alexander Strong alias Alexander Strong Martin the following negroes to wit Dick, Isaac, Jack, Congo, and Asney. — and after the death of his mother Elizabeth Strong I give him Fan to him his heirs and assigns for ever. —

Item I give to the use of the above said Elizabeth Strong my said negro Girl Fan for and during her natural life after wards to be disposed of as in the Last article. —

Item I give and devise to my nephew Thomas Rogers one half of my tract of Land called the great creek of Lan in Stokes County the Lower part thereof together with one half of three hundred acres adjacent thereto I hold in partnership with Col. John Martin. — to hold to him his heirs and assigns for ever. — Also I give to the use of the

said Thomas Rogers and Mary his wife for and during their natural lives my negro Boys Alfred and Sam afterwards I give the same to their child as they in their life time shall order to, them their heirs and assigns for ever. —

Item I give and devise unto my nephew Hugh Martin the upper part of the above tract of the great creek of Lan river, and the other part of tract of Land held in partnership with Col. John Martin both which tracts, contains half of said Lands, to hold to him his heirs and assigns for ever. —

Item I give and bequeath to my nephew Alexander Henderson commonly called Captain Henderson of the butler son of Thomas Henderson my tract of four hundred and twenty acres lying in Guilford County on the waters of Potocah to hold to him his heirs and assigns for ever. —

Item I give and bequeath to my four Nephews James Rogers, Samuel Rogers, Robert Rogers, and Nathaniel Henderson son of Thomas Henderson, the residue of my Harpeth Land in the state of Tennessee which residue will contain eight hundred and fourteen acres to be equally divided among them equally in quantity and quality each to have his choice according to the order their names stand in this Item to hold to them and each of them their heirs and each of their heirs and assigns for ever. —

Item I give and bequeath to my nephew Samuel A Martin one half of my Catabaw plantation in Lincoln County, the upper part thereof including the Ferry, to hold to him his heirs and assigns for ever. Also I give and bequeath the use of the following

negroes to ~~him~~ and his wife Mary for
and during their natural lives to ~~for~~
Franch Amoretta his wife & two children
George, Rose and Morais to hold to their
own use, and each of them use as above
afterwards the said negroes and their
increase to be at the disposal of the said
Samuel and Mary to such of of their
children they may think proper to hold
to hold to them their heirs and assigns
for ever. ~~to judge to be supposed him during his~~
I give and devise the lower part of said tract
of land and plantation on the Catawba river
aforesaid being the other half to my nephew
Samuel Henderson junr. to hold to him his
heirs and assigns for ever.
I give and devise to my nephew Thomas Henderson
junr. my lot of land lying in Raleigh City
adjoining W. Secretary White's lot where
he lives - also my house and lot in the
town of Martinsville, Guilford County,
and half of all the lots and land
adjacent thereto I hold in partnership
with his father Thomas Henderson
undisposed of - to hold to him his
heirs and assigns forever. - I also give
him my negro boy Frank son of
Stesse. I give and bequeath to my
niece Jane Caldwell Martin my
negro woman Mattinba, her children
Swillie, and Exers and future
increase, Stacey, daughter of Harrah
and her brother Charles, to her, her
heirs and assigns forever - also a
riding mare and good saddle
together with a Bed & furniture
and a common outfit of table
furniture, suitable for Breakfast
and dinner, including a set of

china and Queens ware vessels including
Hess; I have already mentioned my man
Prince that my will and pleasure
is he should be set free. It is also my
desire to extend the same favour to
my man Ben and his wife Sarah,
his children Ambrose, Charles, Sweeney,
Lucy and her children Jesse and
Maccajah Matkins, and all her
future children, and I do by these
presents, and as far as the Law
will enable me set the said negro
Ben his wife, children and family
aforesaid free from the service of all
and every manner and kind of person
whomever - and I do hereby request
the Worshipful County Court of Rocking-
ham or General assembly where appli-
cation may be made to confirm this
my last will and pleasure. I also
include in the above request my man
Prince aforesaid who is also justly en-
titled to this favor being a true, confident
tial, and faithful servant. As to my man
Ben, his services entitle him to this favour
from his great fidelity to me in his private
capacity, but when his public services are
considered they must be deemed highly
meritorious by his Country. It is well
known and I hereby certify that he served
his Country three years in the Continental
service under my Command, faithfully, and
with reputation as a soldier, and poor
fellow being an humble friend, companion
and servant bravely risked his life to obtain
that liberty, from British domination
for his master and Country, which liberty
he was incapable of enjoying the sweets
and benefits of, and conscious of the

inability - and that the said Ben and his family may not become burthensome to the public I hereby give and devise to him under the name of Benjamin Harris Martin four hundred acres of land lying on the Guilford road, and forty in Rockingham County being the upper part of my first Grant on said Road including the improvements first made by David Wall, to hold to him his heirs and assigns forever - I also give and bequeath to the said Benjamin Harris Martin, two good work horses, two cows & calves, two plough-hoes, two axes, and two grubbing hoes with two sows & pigs as my executor herein after named shall Order and direct to him his heirs and assigns forever - And that the public may have good security for the good behaviour of the said Benjamin Harris Martin and his family as above mentioned and also for Prince I hereby acknowledge myself indebted to the State of North Carolina five hundred pounds, to be always void when no Breach can be proved for five years.

Item I give and devise to Prince under the name of Prince Martin one hundred and forty acres of land lying on the said Guilford Road on the lower part of my second Grant on said Road adjacent to the land laid off hereby to Benjamin H. Martin, to hold to him his heirs and assigns forever - I also give him one horse, one cow and calf and a sow and pigs.

Item I give and devise to David Wall two hundred acres of land being the lower end of my first Grant of land on the Guilford Road including the improvement where his family now live to hold to him his heirs & assigns forever.

Item I give and devise to my brother James Martin, Col. James Hunter,

Thomas Henderson, and Alexander Martin my Wearaset and entry of five thousand acres of land lying near the iron Bank of the Mississippi river on the north western corner of the State of Tennessee, to be equally divided among them in quality & quantity to hold to them and each of them, their heirs and each of their heirs and assigns forever. Item I give and devise to Arthur Hays five hundred acres of land being my residue of my second Grant of land lying on the Guilford Road near Bethell meeting house to hold to him his heirs and assigns forever. I also give him Abram and such to him his heirs and assigns forever.

Item I give and bequeath to Mr. Frohock my small sword having received it as a present from his father my friend Mr. Thos. Frohock with this contingency the longest lives should have and enjoy it at the time I had the honour to hold the Government of the State. I have thought proper, after experiencing this mark of friendship to return the same to the source from whence it came, I request Mr. Frohock to deposit this sword among the archives of his family, as it was a present from Mr. Henry Gustave M. Bullock to his uncle John Frohock for several services rendered him & from his uncle, the same descended to his father - which small sword the said Alexander Frohock is to hold to him his heirs & assigns forever.

Item I give and bequeath to my brother James' wife Martha Martin my Chariot and furniture to hold to her and my said brother their heirs and assigns forever.

Item I give and bequeath my silver coffee pot and stand of silver with my sugar dish to my sister Jane Henderson my tea pot and milk pot with my silver table spoons to my sister Martha Rogers to them and each of them, their heirs

and each of their heirs and assigns forever
my other silver to be equally divided between
them together with my china & other table
furniture.

Item I Give and bequeath my law Books
to my two nephews Thomas Rogers and
Alexander M. Rogers to be equally divided
between them; my Encyclopedias I give to
my nephew James Martin Junr, all my
other books, classical, scientific, and of a
miscellaneous nature I give & bequeath
to the said Alexander M. Rogers & James
Martin to be equally divided between
them as to value and quantity to them,
and each of them their heirs & assigns
forever.

Item I Give and bequeath to my brother
James my Blacksmith's tools, and my
negro girl Grace, Brann's daughter, to
hold to him his heirs and assigns
forever - Jack and his tools not to be
removed till finishing my second crop.

Item I Give and bequeath to Martha
Rogers Junr. commonly called Patsy
Rogers my negro girl Kate Brann's
daughter, to her, her heirs & assigns forever
- Jack and his tools & indentured before execution.

Item I omitted mentioning my Luke's
Cabin tract of land on Lacey's Cross roads
I order and direct that the same be
sold with my other lands, and the monies
after paying debts as already directed
should any, appear to be divided
between my brothers James & Robert
and sisters Martha and Jane; my
Executor to execute a deed in fee simple
for the same.

Item, I Give and bequeath to my Doctor
Samuel Henderson Junr. my negro
Boy Limerie to hold to him his heirs
and assigns forever.

Item I Give & bequeath to my afore-
mentioned natural son Alexander
Strong alias Alexander Strong Martin
my stall, three horses, cattle & hogs

hereby bequeathed him, to hold to him his

Lastly I constitute, appoint and ordain
my friend and relation Col. James Hunter
to be the Executor of this my last will and
testament from the great trust & confidence
I place in his honesty and integrity, of which
I have been a witness and had the expe-
rience many years, hereby ratifying and
confirming this to be my last will and
testament, and annulling all others.

- my wearing apparel I divide between
my brother James and Robert

Children being given him and his wife - The said P^r I give and bequeath to my nephew Hugh Martin and her future increase to have and to hold to him his heirs and assigns forever - Her son I give I bequeath to my nephew James Martin Jun^r to wit Ben, to have and to hold to him his heirs and assigns forever - Charity P^r's daughter I give and bequeath to Fanny Henderson daughter of my brother-in-law Thomas Henderson to have and to hold to her her heirs and assigns forever - &c. &c. daughter interlined before Execution

Item I should James Martin Jun^r to whom I have given the remainder of my Wambury plantation after the death of Thos Henderson and his wife, or before die, without lawful issue, I hereby give, bequeath and devise the said plantation with the appurtenances to my nephew Alex^r M. Rogers to have and to hold to him his heirs and assigns forever - I also give him my stone knee buckles -

Item I give and bequeath to my son Alex^r Martin my horse Solah to have and to hold to him his heirs & assigns forever together with my saddle & Bridle - also a mare I heretofore gave him

Item I give to my sister Martha Rogers my tea tray to her and her heirs & assigns forever - &c. &c. The word /die/ interlined before execution.

Item, after the death of my sister Rogers I give and bequeath Bill and Thos to my nephew James Rogers for the care he has taken of his mother and her family to hold to him his heirs and assigns forever confirming them to my sister only as a life estate

Item I give and bequeath to Eliza Pleasant Henderson one of my Silver tumblers and to my brother James I give and bequeath the other to have and to hold to them and each of them their heirs and assigns forever - I also give my said brother my Spectacles set in silver -

Lastly I Alexander Martin do hereby ratify and confirm this Codicil to be a part of my said last Will and testament, revoking and disannulling all bequests and legacies mentioned in my said last Will and Testament that come within the purview & meaning of this Codicil.
