In the name of God Amen I Ann Booker
Overton of Rockingham County, State of North
Carolina being sick the off perfect mind and
memory do make and ordain this my last will
and Testament in manner and form as follows
I give and bequeath to my beloved Daughter
Mary Overton the tract of land I now live upon
to her, her heirs and assigns for ever

Whereas by the last will & Testament of my late husband
John Overton I have in the State of Kentucky
two tracts of land containing one thousand
acres which lands I devise as follows, One tract
of Eight hundred acres on which my son John
Overton has built a saw mill, I devise to my
three children (to wit) Mary Overton I give
four hundred acres to Fanny Carr Overton, I
give three hundred acres to William Overton
I give one hundred acres to them their heirs and
assigns for ever to be equally divided according
to quality

It is my will and pleasure that the remaining
two hundred acres in the State of Kentucky shall
be sold by my Executor herein after to be named
on a Credit of six, ^{under} eighteen, months and the
moneys arising from the sale of said lands
to be applied to the payment of my just
debts and if there should not be a sufficiency
of money to pay my debts arising from the sale
of said land my Executor is by the direction
of my Daughter Mary to sell part of either
of the tracts of land which I have herein
devoted to her she to have her choice which

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land shall be sold and such money to apply to
the discharge of my just debts and if any
balance should be in the hand of my Executor
to apply it the use of my said Daughter Mary
Lastly I nominate, constitute and appoint my
Trusty friend Thomas Carey Executor of this
my last will and testament I Testimony
whereof I have hereunto set my hand and
seal the day of - A.D. 1809

ture which she has in possession also I give her
the sum of thirty dollars to be raised out my
Estate to make her portion Equal with the rest
above mentioned

And I give and bequeath unto my son Mon, Sillard
one horse which he has in his possession and I
further give him one bed and furniture out of
my Estate and one cow and calf

And I give and bequeath unto my son Thomas Sillard
one horse one cow and calf and one bed and
furniture to be raised out of my Estate

And lastly my will and desire is that my beloved
wife Ellender Sillard shall have all the remain-
der of my real and personal Estate after paying
all my just debts during her natural life and
then to be equally divided among all my children
to them and their heirs forever

And it further my will and desire that my beloved
wife Ellender Sillard my son Mon Sillard and
John Forrest be Executors to this my last will
and testament signed sealed and confirmed
the twenty fourth day of October in the year
of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & thirteen in the
