In the name of God Amen I William Harrison of the
 County of Rockingham and State of North Carolina being
 of sound perfect mind and memory (blessed be God) do this
 sixth day of April in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred
 and twenty six make and publish this my last Will
 and testament in manner following that is to say First
 I give and bequeath unto My beloved Wife, Wm. Harrison all that
 tract of land whereon I now live Except that of the same that I do hereinafter
 after dispose of to my Friend Thomas Siles together with all the crop that
 I may die possessed of and all the House hold and Kitchen Furniture
 plantation Utensils of Every description together with all my stock
 of Every description consisting of Horses cattle sheep Hogs &c.
 to her free from all Incumbrances Whatsoever

I give and bequeath unto my son John Harrison Six Negroes
 namely, Abraham, William, Mary, Jude, Isaac, David, to him and
 his heirs forever

I give and bequeath to Each of My Sons, Namely William
 Zachariah, Sterling & Lendon one dollar each to be paid by
 my executor to them & their heirs forever

I give and bequeath unto my trusty friend Thomas Siles the
 following piece or parcel of land lying and being in the County
 and State of said adjoining the land of Thomas Siles own

bounded as followeth Beginning at said Siles corner on the Creek then
 down the Creek as it Meanders to Bradnaxes line thence along his
 line to Mrs. Mouchards line thence along his line to the Siles line
 thence along his line to the Beginning and containing fifty acres
 be the same more or less also the three following Negroes namely
 Isaac Aggy & child Thomas to him and his heirs forever
 And I do hereby make certain my last Will and Testament
 int. In Witness Whereof I the said William Harrison
 have to this my last Will and testament set my hand
 and seal the day and year above written.
 Signed sealed published and
 declared by the said William Harrison
 as his last
 Will and testament in the presence
 of us who were present at the time
 of signing and sealing thereof

In the name of God Amen I Benjamin Dilworth
 Senr of the County of Rockingham State of North Carolina
 being of a perfect & sound mind & memory do this
 twentieth day of July in the Year of our Lord one thou-
 sand eight hundred and twenty six make publish
 this my last will & Testament in manner following
 that is to say, First I do give & bequeath unto My Son
 George Dilworth my tract of land on which I live &
 the piece which I bought of Abraham (Deeble) being all
 the land I now hold entirely to do with at pleasure

After my death I do also give & bequeath unto him the said
 George Dilworth, during his life my Negro man York my
 my negro woman Jane my boy John my boy Solomon
 and my girl Fervine also all my Stock Household and
 Kitchen furniture & all my farming utensils of every de-
 scription & denomination and at his decease to be dispo-
 sed of as herein After mentioned.
 Secondly I do give & bequeath unto my four sons Thomas
 Dilworth Richard Dilworth Abraham Dilworth and
 Isaac Dilworth, my three Negro girls Sarah Elizabeth &
 Emily & my boy Prison to be put up at Sale among the four
 only by my executor excluding the liberty of any & every
 other bidder than the said four (or in case they should not
 be all living the sale of negroes suspended & they held until a
 proper Guardian shall be appointed to act in behalf of the Heirs
 of such legacies if any as may not be of lawful age and the said
 Negroes purchased in by the said four sons (or Guardian in
 their stead) and the difference in value to be paid over by
 to each other untill all is made equal. Thirdly I do give &
 bequeath unto all children of my deceased Daughter Mary
 Davis ten Dollars to be equally divided between them.
 Fourthly I do give & bequeath unto the children of my de-
 ceased son John Dilworth Twenty five Dollars to be equally divided among
 them. Fifthly as to the Negro property left my son George Dilworth
 during his life (should he have no heirs at his decease)
 to be divided among Thomas Dilworth Richard Dilworth
 Abraham Dilworth & Isaac Dilworth in the same manner
 of the above described division among them but should
 George have any Heirs then I do give & bequeath unto him
 & his Heirs forever. York Jane & Golden then the other two
 negroes John & Fervine to be sold to the highest bidder
 of the four sons by my executor as above stated Thomas
 Richard Abraham & Isaac or the proper Guardian in
 their stead. As to the Stock Household & Kitchen
 furniture farming utensils & tools of every description

left to George Dilworth during his life in the first Clause of
 this my last & testament. I do give & bequeath unto him the
 the said George & his heirs forever (should he have any
 Heirs) but should he die having no Heirs then all the old Stock
 Household & Kitchen furniture and tools of every description that
 that can be ascertained to be of the old Stock of such stock
 of which I may die ^{2d} to be divided in the same way
 of the division of the negro property among the said Thomas
 Richard Abraham & Isaac Dilworth. As to all the resi-
 due of my Estate of which I may die after the
 payment of such legacies as is herein provided &
 the expence of a decent interment of my body ex-
 pended then the remainder to be equally divided among
 my four sons Thomas Dilworth Richard Dilworth
 Abraham Dilworth & Isaac Dilworth except that
 George Dilworth and the family of Blacks left to him
 & the Stock &c have sufficient support to meet the
 next ensuing crop. And I do nominate appoint
 ordain Mark Willingsworth of the County of Guilford
 and State of North Carolina Sole Executor of this
 my last will and Testament in witness whereof I
 have hereunto set my hand and seal the day
 and year first above written Signed Sealed pronoun-
 ced & declared by the said Benjamin Dilworth
 as his last will and Testament in the
 presence of us who in his presence and
 in the presence of each other have hereunto
 Subscribed our names as
