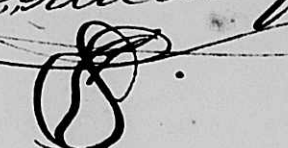

In the name of God amen I Chastain Roberts of the
 county of Rockingham and state of north carolina
 being in a low state of health but of sound of perfect
 mind and memory do make this my last will and
 testament as follows first I recommend my soul to
 God that gave it me and my body to the earth to be
 buried in a decent like manner and as to my worldly
 Estate that it hath pleased God to lend to me. I bequea-
 the them as follows. I now and bequeath that all my
 Just debts be paid I now and bequeath unto my be-
 loved wife Polly Roberts four negroes to wit, Frank
 and his wife Ann a negro boy Sam on and girl
 Blancia also all my property real and personal what-
 ever in this state or in the state of Virginia with
 all arrears I owe or on money due at this time or
 which may become due hereafter in the state
 aforesaid or in any other state to her and the lawful
 heirs of her body forever Lastly I appoint my beloved
 wife Polly Roberts and William Bethelle my lawful
 executors in witness whereof I have hereunto set my
 hand and seal this 30th day of July 1816

consisting of five negroes viz Louis James Lemman
Leamthy and Alecy two head of horses the stock of hogs
cattle and sheep which is now on the tract of land called
Loel Estes which tract is owned by Genl. G. B. and with
all the remnant or remnants remainers or remainances
of property owned by me as well as all claims of every kind
and description which is now due me or which may
become due me either in Law or Equity I hereby appoint
Philip Rose my beloved Brother my executor to carry into
full effect this my will and 2nd I hereby make and
confirm all or any other will or wills which may
appear in my name as declaring this to be my
last will given under my hand and seal this 28th March

personal estate as can best be spared and the leg-
acies hereinafter bequeathed are to be as charged
as soon as circumstances will permit and in the
manner aforesaid
I give to my son James Roberts his heirs and assigns
forever I give and bequeath in order more fully
to confirm to him and his heirs the tract of land
known as containing one hundred and eighty
acres more or less and for which he has a deed from
my wife simple which together with sundry
other personal property which he has now in possession
