Seventhly make and ordain my son William Nelson Executor of this my last will and testament in witness whereof I the said Agnes Nelson have to this my last will and testament set my hand and seal the day and year above written signed sealed published and acknowledged by the said Agnes Nelson as her last will and testament in the presence of us who were present at the time of signing and sealing thereof. 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In the name of God Amen I Constant Perkins being very low and weak in body but of perfect mind as usual once calling to mind the certainty of death and uncertainty of life make this my last will and testament to wit after all my last debts are paid I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Agatha Perkins the negro slave Patt and her child Tilda Pitt and her three children Harry Rachel and Pinner to her and her heirs forever and all my house hold goods and stock except a small mare & colt a blaze face mare I bought of hollow & the station which my will is shall be sold towards the payment of my debts and the use of the tract of land and plantation on Bear River whereon I now live I lend to my wife during her natural life and at her death I give and bequeath the said land to my Brother Nicholas Perkins son Constant Perkins to him and his heirs forever and my negro wall Arch Asham Sarah Minah Velora Snobe Liba Rona Eligah and Flora I give to my brother Nicholas Perkins to him and his heirs forever and I give and bequeath to my well beloved nephew Nicholas Perkins son of Charles Perkins all my land on the western waters that are in partnership with John Mann Nicholas Perkins and company and in particular six hundred and forty acres of land purchased by William Armstrong in Cumberland and the small house he now has in possession and my will and desire is that my negro man Jacob be immediately set free and my will and

In the name of God Amen I Nathaniel Seales
of the County of Rockingham and State of north
Carolina do make and enact this my last will
and testament to wit

First it is my will and desire that all my just debts
be paid in the manner hereafter provided

Second I give and bequeath to my son Joseph Seales
the following negro slaves to wit Peter Sybra and
two children Pua and her two youngest children
named Susa and Sham with all their increase
from this time also six hundred dollars to be paid
to him or shall hereafter be due due to him &
his heirs forever

Thirdly I give and bequeath to my daughter Sally
Neal the following negro slaves to wit Little
Jacob full his wife and her child them Philip
Hannah his wife and her two children named
Beck and Charles with all their increase from
this time to her and her heirs forever

Fourth I give and bequeath to my daughter
Mary with the following negro slaves to wit
Quack and four of her children named Liza

Ben Aaron and Richard Gary them a child of
Pussy Little Poll and Sham (children of old Poll)
with all their increase from this time to her and her
heirs forever

Fifth I give and bequeath to my son Henry Seales
the following negro slaves to wit Abraham Michael
Pitty and her two children Lora and her two chil-
dren old Sham and Polly his wife with all their
increase from this time to him and his heirs forever

Sixth I give and bequeath unto my daughter Polly
Webb all my interest in the tract of land and
Mills commonly called and known by the name of the
Rock on condition that she shall pay to my son

Joseph Seales the sum of six hundred dollars
three hundred dollars of which to be paid in twelve
months after my decease and three hundred dollars
in two years after my decease and that she shall
pay the further sum of nine hundred dollars to be
applied to the payment of my debts to her and her
heirs forever

Seventh It is my will that the following negro
slaves to wit Thomas and her five children and
Alec together with all their increase from this time
be for the use and benefit of my daughter Betty
Wright during her natural life and at her
death to be equally divided between the heirs of
her body or their heirs to them and their heirs for-
ever and I do give and bequeath to my son in
law John Wright a bond executed by him to
me on the nineteenth day of November one thou-
sand eight hundred and twenty one for the sum
of twelve hundred and six dollars and I do
hereby discharge him from the payment of the
same or any part thereof

Eighth I give and bequeath to my son Alfred
Seales the lower part of my land on Dan
River to be surveyed as follows Beginning at the
