I bequeath fifty dollars in cash. also to my two
Daughters Mary & Jeany. fifty dollars cash each
I the said John Dilworth do in this my last
will make & appoint my beloved Sons Thomas
& John Dilworth Executors of my estate.

Ratify this revoking all other former wills
where unto I have this day set my hand and seal
the 7th day of May 1808

name of Sam and Hampton, also I give to

to my son Stephen two negroes by the name of
Jack and Sunday and two named Union
and Mary and all the rest my residue to be
equally divided among my surviving sons and
Daughters relieving this and no other to be
my last Will and Testament In witness
whereof I have hereunto set my hand and
seal this twenty fifth day of February in the
year of our Lord Eighteen hundred and Eight

my Body and knowing that it is appointed for all
men once to die do make ordain, and constitute
this my last Will and Testament (that it to say)
Principally and first of all I recommend my soul
into the protection of almighty God who gave it
hoping at the general resurrection I shall shine
with him in the topsy regions of Eternal Bliss, my
Body I recommend to the Earth to be buried in a
decent and Christian like manner as the dis-
cretion of my Executors

And as touching such worldly Estate with which

wish to be sold, I further give unto my beloved
wife her choice of one horse or mare out of my
Stock of horses, her choice of two Cows and calves
with her choice of Ewe and Lamb also one sow
and pig. I further give and bequeath unto
my beloved wife one negro woman known by
the name of Harriet and her issue during
her natural life and after her death the said
negro woman Harriet and her issue I give and
bequeath unto my beloved Daughter Rebecca
Grant and Polly Grant to be equally divided
amongst them

It is further my will and desire that a copy
