Then I give and bequeath to my son Joseph Black
my next eldest sonne man to that given to my
said son Pleasant Black, I also give and
bequeath to my said Son Joseph Black one
feather bed and furniture.

I give and bequeath to my son John Black
my youngest sonne man both also one feather
bed and furniture

My further will and desire is that my just
Ditti be paid out of the money due to me from
sundry persons and that which may be raised from
the sale of the residue of my property not
herefore bequeathed, and in case there should be a
surplus or balance remaining after paying my debts and
funeral charges my will and desire is that such balance
or surplus be equally divided between my seven children
that is to say Polly Jackson, Anna Wright, Pleasant
Black, Elizabeth Webster, Joseph Black, John
Black, and known Martha Black.

not notwithstanding the clause in the will immediatly preced-
ing this, my will and desire is that my three children now
living with my say Joseph Black John Black

and Caroline Hartley Black shall have the Stock of
provisions now on hand or so much thereof as will be
sufficient for their comfortable and decent support for

of the Stock and ten head of Hogs choice
of my Stock and two feathered Brassard
furniture choice of my Brassards and food stains
choice of the chairs that belong to the house
and one grey mare and her own bridle and
saddle and one Bay Horse two years old the
best of the man I call Pat, and one
table the choice of the tables I now own
and all the Kitchen Furniture and cupboard
and cupboard furniture, and one plot and one
set of Gung and one Sheet which was
always called her own Sheet, It is under
too that none of the above property left my
wife is to be a her disposal except the negro boy
Abraham but at her death all the rest of
what remains is to be returned into my estate
give to my son Ezra Brasher the sum
of ten Dollars

give to my Daughter Maggy Ford ten
Dollars
