In the name of God amen. Ezekiel Jones of the
of Stockingham and state of North Carolina being
weak in body but of a sound mind and memory do
this 17th day of November in the year of our Lord
one thousand eight hundred and twenty three
make and sign this my last will and testa-
ment hereby revoking and making void all
will and testaments hereunto by me made.

First of all I give and bequeath to my dearly
beloved wife Rosannah Jones the plantation
which I now live on together with a negro man
by the name of Isaac a son of the christians
and my pig and two cows and calves six head of
sheep six heds of the best hogs two bears and
their furniture together with all the house hold
and kitchen furniture the loom and all the
plantation tools to be for her use during her
natural life and at her decease all the property
then remaining to be sold and the tract of
land on which I now live and the money arising
therefrom to be equally divided between the
four following children (Viz) my son James
Jones my son John Jones my Daughter Sarah Lee
and my son Ananee Jones
Item I also give and bequeath to Edward Lapping
the sum of one Dollar.

Item I also give and bequeath to my Daughter
Mary the sum of one Dollar
and it is my will and desire that my negro man
Jones together with the rest of my property not

not mentioned at my decease be left and equally
divided amongst my son James Jones
my Daughter Sarah Lee and my son Ananee Jones
I artly I appoint and ordain my two sons James
Jones and John Jones executors of this my last will
and testament in witness whereof I have unto
set my hand and annex my seal this day and
date first written signe sealed and affirmed
in the presence of us. Ezekiel Jones Esq;

wile that the negro man Isaac be sold on a course
of twelve months and the money for which he
shall sell to go the use of my wife during her life
2nd I do also wish and desire that my grand daughter
Elizabeth have in schooling or property to the
amount of twenty five dollars
