In the name of God amen. Isabel Jones of the
of Rockingham and State of North Carolina being
weak in body but of a sound mind and memory do
this 27th day of December in the year of our Lord
one thousand eight hundred and twenty five
make and publish this my last will and testa-
ment hereby revoking and making void all
wills whosoever heretofore by me made.

I first of all give and bequeath to my dearly
beloved wife Hannah Jones the plantation
which I now live on together with a negro man
by the name of Isaac and one of the choicest
and my pig and two cows and calves six head of
sheep six head of the best hogs and bees and
their furniture together with all the house hold
and kitchen furniture the loom and all the
plantation tools to be for her use during her
natural life and at her decease all the property
then remaining to be sold and the tract of
land on which I now live and the money aris-
ing therefrom to be equally divided between the
four following children (Viz) my son James
Jones my son John Jones my Daughter Sarah Orr
and my son Amos Jones

Item I also give and bequeath to Edward Lapping
the sum of one Dollar.

Item I also give and bequeath to my Daugh-
ter Mary Kate the sum of one Dollar
and it is my will and desire that my negro man
Lina together with the rest of my property not

not mentioned at my Decease be sold and equally
divided amongst my said Sons James Jones
my Daughter Sarah Orr and my son Amos Jones
Lastly I appoint and ordain my two sons James
Jones and John Jones Executors of this my last will
and testament in witness whereof I do hereunto
set my hand and annex my seal this day and
date first written Signed sealed and delivered
in the presence of us. Isabel Jones Ed

the following bequest that is It is my will and
wish that the negro man Isaac be sold on a credit
of twelve months and the money for which he
shall sell to go the use of my wife during her life
2nd I do also wish and desire that my grand daughter
Elizabeth have in schooling or property to the
amount of twenty five dollars.
