Rockingham County being in perfect mind and memory do make Constitution and Ordain this my last will and Testament in manner and form following I promise give and bequeath to my son Gideon Johnson the lands and plantations wherein I now dwelle with the appurtenances there unto belonging containing by estimation one hundred & forty ~~Acres~~^{Acre} five acres the same more or less to him my said son his heirs and assigns for ever - Item I give & bequeath to my Grand Daughter Ursula Featherage one leather bed & furniture thenceunto belonging to her she being Item I give & bequeath to my four Sons (viz) William Allen, Horatio & Peter Johnsons also to my four daughters (viz) Elizabeth May Judith Condon Naomi Johnson Ursula Pitts & Nancy Cotton and to each of them five Shillings Sterling each of them having already received the part of my estate allotted them so that they are to have no more Item I order will and desire after my just debts are all paid all the rest residue & remainder of my personal estate be it what nature kind or quality so ever to my said son Gideon given to him his heirs for ever - Item I order will and desire that my estate shall not be appraised nor my executors compelled to give security for the performance of this will & matters herein contained & lastly I appoint Constitution and Ordain my son Gideon Johnson Executor of this my last will & Testament hoping he will see the same duly performed as my trust in ~~in~~ him is reposed hereby making void all other will & will Testaments & testaments by me made and Confirming this & none other to be my last will and testament in testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 2nd day October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seven signed sealed and delivered in presence of Gideon Johnson Seal
