 I Isaac Lowe of the County of Rockingham
 & State of North Carolina Being weak
 of Body but of Sound & perfect Memory—
 Do make Constitute and ordain this my
 Last Will & Testament. In form &
 manner Following Viz. To my Beloved
 Wife Catharine Lowe I will & Bequeath
 all my Personal Estate Together with
 my Land and negroes During her nat
 life & then to be Disposed of in the
 following manner which will be
 hereafter mentioned.

To my son Thomas Lowe I will & Bequeath
 the Tract of Land I now live on at my
 said wifes Death to him & his heirs for
 Ever likewise Two Beds which is now
 in his possession I also Bequeath to him
 and his heirs &c.

To my daughter Margaret Moore I Give & Bequeath
 one Bed & furniture also at my wifes Death—
 To my Daughter Franky Edmonson I give & Bequeath
 also one Bed & furniture in the manner as above
 mentioned—

To my Daughter Fanny Pearson I Give & Bequeath
 at my wifes death as much property which
 she may make choice of as will be in Value to a
 Good Bed & furniture.—

To my son in Law Samuel Moor & my Daughter in Law
 Mary Lowe I give & Bequeath to each five shelling
 I Bequeath my Warring Apparet and Saddle to my
 said son Thomas Lowe.—

And all the Remainder of my Personal
 estate my wifes Death I Bequeath to my
 four children To (wit) Thomas Lowe Margot
 Moor Franky Edmonson & Fanny Pearson
 to be Equally Divided amongst them— And
 as to my said Negroes which I am now
 possessed of It is my will and Desire at
 my said wifes Death for the True and
 Faithfull services which they have perform
 to me I do hereby Absolutely Ordain that
 they be set free all that I am possessed
 of for that I may hereafter be possess'd with
 my One Negroe Woman Named Nell the
 wife of a certain free man Named
 Charles Friend; Two Negroes men One named
 Jack the other Charles four negro girls
 & woman Black Mary Bett & Alley & an
 also one Negroe Boy named James like
 wise Two children of the above mentioned
 Beck Hannah and Friend I do by Virtue of

This My Last will and Testament Ordain that they be free, Men & Woman as above mentioned I do Likewise Constitute & appoint Andrew Boyd My whole and sole Executor of this My will & Trust to see the same duly performed and Executed, revoking and Rescinding all wills heretofore made by me I witness of which I have set my hand this 14th day of February 1806 signed sealed published & pronounced in presence of

I Gideon Johnson Senr of the state North Carolina Rockingham County being in perfect mind and memory do Make constitute and ordain this my last will & Testament in manner & form following— Impairmus I give & Bequeath to my son Gideon Johnson the Land & Plantation whereon I now dwell with the Appertinements thereunto belonging

Containing by Estimation One hundred & forty five acres, be the same more or less, to him my said son his heirs and assigns for ever— Item I give & Bequeath to my Grand Daughter Ursula Deatherage one Feather Bed & Furniture thereto belonging to her & her heirs for ever— Item I give & Bequeath to my four sons (Viz) William Abner, Mordecai & Peter Johnsons Also to my five Daughters (Viz) Elizabeth Ray, Judith Condon, Naomi Johnson Ursula Piller, & Nancey Cotton & to each of them five shillings sterling each of them having already received the part of my Estate allotted them, so that they are to have no more— Item I Order will & desire, after my just debts are paid, all the rest, residue & remainder of my Personal Estate be it what nature kind or quality so ever, to my said son Gideon given to him his heirs for ever— Item I Order will & desire that my Estate shall not be appraised. Nor my Executor compelled to give security for the performance of this will & matters herein contained & lastly I do appoint constitute & Order my Son Gideon Johnston Executor of this my last will & Testament hoping he will see the same duly performed as my Trust in him is reposed hereby making void all other will and wills, Testaments & Testamentary by me made & confirming this & none other to be my Last will & Testament— In Testimony whereof I have here unto set my hand & Friend my seal this 2 day October in the Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & seven
