Armstrong of the County of Rockingham
and State of North Carolina being in
sound mind health feeling to mind the mor-
tality of my body and uncertainty of
life do here make this instrument of
writing as my last will and testament in
manner and form following that is to say
first I commend my soul into the hands of
almighty god who give me assistance and my
body to a christian decently buried at the
discretion of my executors who I here to
nominate and appoint I give all my goods

Chattels lands and tenements to my wife
Polly during her natural life and then to
the heirs of her body and I further
hereby nominate and appoint loving wife
Polly Armstrong and my friend Sam-
Wardlow executors of this my last will
and testament in witness whereof

but of perfect mind and memory and calling
to mind the mortality of my body and
knowing that it is appointed for all men once
to die do make and ordain this my last will
and testament in the following manner

In the first place I give and bequeath to
Rebecca Hays Daughter of Salar Hays
one bed and furniture also I give and bequeath
to my loving wife Rebecca Alet all my
land tenements stock household furniture
with all I possess wholly and solely to be
hers to live on and dispose of as ^{her} prudence
proposes
