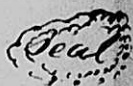

In the name of God amen I John Dilworth
of said state & County being weak in body
but of sound and perfect mind & ~~body~~ ^{body}
thanks be to God for it, knowing that I and
all men were born to die.

I do make & declare this my last will &
Testament, disposing of my worldly

Estate, after a decent burial and my Just debts
paid in the following manner, viz.

First I bequeath to my oldest son George Dilworth
the sum of Ten shillings currency of said state
and County.

Secondly I bequeath to my son Thomas Dilworth
the next oldest one half of the Tract of land
that I now live on & his half To be where he
now lives, the other half of the land where I
now live to my Youngest son John Dilworth
to be equally divided between them & further for
this consideration to take care & sufficiently
in all respects whatsoever, maintain my Afflic-
ed son Benjamin Dilworth equally between
them & moreover for the better Enabling the
two sons Thomas & John Dilworth to maintain
sufficiently their Brother Benjamin Dilworth.

3. I give & bequeath Each of them one negro man
apiece Caleb to my son Thomas Dilworth
and Gil the other negro to my son John
Dilworth - also to the above John my son I
bequeath one bedstead & furniture, also to my
son Benjamin Dilworth one bed and furni-
ture.

Fourthly I give and bequeath to my above named sons
Thomas and John Dilworth my still & every thing
there to belonging. and my waggon to be equally
divided between them.

Fifthly To my Daughter Mary Dilworth I give

bequeath the negro girl named Jude two beds
and furniture one cow and calf one bay mare
called ^{one that more than the rest} ~~hand~~ ^{one} dresser and its furniture
as it now stands to be equally divided between
her and her brother John my stock of hogs, cattle,
hogs, & sheep & their increase to be equally divi-
ded between my son John, & my Daughters

Mary Dilworth and my Daughter Elizabeth
Boye & Jeany Reed. To my son John Dilworth
I bequeath all the household furniture that
has not been mentioned. To my Daughter
I bequeath fifty dollars in cash. also to my two
Daughters Mary & Jeany. fifty dollars cash each
I the said John Dilworth do in this my last
will make & appoint my beloved Sons Thomas
& John Dilworth Executors of my estate.

Notifying this revoking all other former wills
where unto I have this day set my hand and seal
the 7th day of May 1808
sealed signed & acknowledged in the presence
of us.
