being of sound mind and memory thanks be given God
calling to mind the mortality of my body do make
and declare this to be my last will and testament in
the manner and form following that is to say first
I give and bequeath my soul to almighty God that
give it me and as to what worldly estate it hath
pleased God to bless me with in this life I give and bequeath
it in the following manner to wit
I leave to my loving wife Sarah Strong during her life

Life all my estate both real and personal and (314)
after her death I give and bequeath my Land contain-
ing three hundred and twenty acres to be the same
more or less to my two sons Robert Strong and Zach-
ariah Strong to be equally divided between them that
is to say my wish is that my son Zachariah should
have my dwelling house and plantation to them their
heirs &c and my wish is that my executor hereafter
mentioned should pay to my son John Strong fifty
pounds Virginia currency and my daughter Agnes
Grogan ten pounds Virginia currency to be paid
out of my said estate if any personal property
should remain that it be equally divided between
the above Robert & Zachariah.

Then I give and bequeath to my two sons Simeon Strong
and William Strong one shilling each.

Lastly I appoint Robert & Zachariah Strong Executors
to this my last will and testament revoking all
former wills by me made in witness whereof I have
hereunto set my hand and seal this twentieth
day of December AD 1798 signed sealed &c
by the said John Strong Senr to be his last will and
testament in the presence of John Strong Junr
Samuel Strong, George Perry Jr.
Mary Strong, Littleton Perry
