I constitute Joseph Gentry & Thomas Peirre Executors of this my last Will and Testament as witness my hand and seal this 6th day of July one thousand eight hundred and eleven

In the name of God Amen I Mary Angelica Roberts of the State of North Carolina and Rockingham County, being of sound mind and memory, though weak of Body, do make and ordain this instrument of writing to be my last Will and testament revoking all others made immediately after my decease my will and desire is that all my just debts be punctually and speedily paid

To my dearly beloved son John Roberts I give and bequeath one new feather Bed and furniture and bedhead, one chest, one snuffe trunk, and all my wearing apparel to him, his heirs & assigns for ever

To my dear daughter Lucia Roberts Daughter of my Sister Elizabeth Roberts, her heirs and assigns for ever. I give and bequeath ten Dollars in money, provided, that the same can be safely conveyed and applied to her particular use and I hereby strictly enjoin it on my Executor herein after named to this clause of my Will shall be executed with fidelity provided notwithstanding that in case my said Executor shall not have it in his power to convey the said legacy of ten Dollars to the said Lucia so that it shall be applied to her particular use and benefit.

Prior to my said son John's becoming of age that he and in that case it shall go to my said son John his heirs and assigns for ever

Immediately after my decease my wife and desire is that the whole of the balance of my Estate consisting of Cottages, household and kitchen furniture &c. shall be sold by my said Executor to the highest bidder at public auction on twelve months endt and the monies arising from such sale or sales

together with all my outstanding debts when
deceased and all money that may be on hand
if any I also give and bequeath to my said son
John Roberts his heirs and assigns for ever
Partly I constitute and appoint my nephew Elias
Roberts of the aforesaid State and County Executor
of this my last will and testament with a regard
that he my said Executor will see that the sum
thus herein before bequeathed to my son John Ro-
berts when deceased shall be put to legal interest
for the use and benefit of my said son John until
he comes of lawful age in estimating wherof
of each and all the matus and things herein
contained I the said Mary Angelica Roberts
