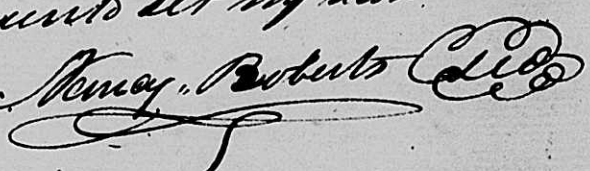
Then I give to my daughter Luekey Lawson Tillar child

Thus my will and desire is that as I had in a former will

 of Vicy, in her life time but having occasion to alter
 my will owing to children born from the woman
 but me ~~my will and desire~~ and several others. Now
 give said boy Alick to the children of my said daughter
 Jincy Schustow and as to the balance of the children
 born from the woman but me my will and desire is
 that they be equally divided among my children.
 Thus as to my own property left me to my own disposal
 I give and dispose of in the following manner I give
 to my son Alfred Bethell Sampson and Abram to him
 and his heirs lawfully begotten of his body but if he
 dies without Lawrell Jane Sampson goes to John
 Bethell and Abram to Lukey Larson.

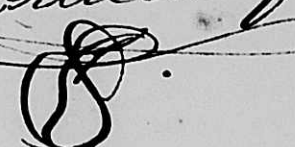
Ann Iqrie Leach and her increase to Nancy Bailey

dies before he comes of age or twenty one my go to his

and her children Agrie Alfred M Bethelle one bed and
furniture beside the one killed him by his father also
a set of curtains and beaded side new window chair
a wooden clock my part of the kitchen and cupboard
furniture also Agrie sinia Bailly my loom and gears
one mettled Tea pot six silver spoons a set of china
a brass skillet the bed left her by her father with one
bed and furniture I have given her since her marriage
my bed and furniture Agrie to sueky Lanson my wish
to be married between John Bethelle Alfred Bethelle &
Linia Bailly the same being made proper and meet
any by the power and direction in me vested by the will
of my former husband William Bethelle and I have
authority to make such will by virtue of marriage
article entered into before marriage between me and
my present husband George Roberts who now testifies
the same by writing this will agreeable to my intention
I appoint my husband George Roberts and John Bethelle
& Alfred Bethelle executors of this my last will and testa-
ment hereby revoking all other wills by me made in
witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal

In the name of God amen I Phastain Roberts of the
county of Rockingham and state of north carolina
being in a low state of health but of sound of perfect
mind and memory do make this my last will and
testament as follows first I recommend my soul to
God that gave it me and my body to the earth to be
buried in a decent like manner and as to my worldly
estate that it hath pleased God to lend to me I bequea-
th them as follows I give and bequeath that all my
Just debts be paid I give and bequeath unto my be-
loved wife Polly Roberts four negroes to wit Frank
and his wife since a negro boy Sam on and girl
Clara also all my property real and personal what-
ever in this state or in the state of Virginia with
all arrears of or on money due at this time or
which may become due hereafter in the state
aforesaid or in any other state to her and the lawful
heirs of her body forever Lastly I appoint my beloved
wife Polly Roberts and William Bethelle my lawful
executors in witness whereof I have hereunto set my
hand and seal this 30th day of July 1816
