I Richard Vanlandingham of the County of Rockingham and State of North Carolina being sick and weak in body but of sound mind and memory do make and ordain this to my last will and testament in manner and form following to wit
First I doord that all my Just debts to paid and discharged by my Executors hereafter named and as to such worldly Estate as it has pleased gods will and wish in this life I dispose of the same as follows.

I give and bequeath unto my youngest son Thomas Vanlandingham (now from information) resident of Woodford County and State of Kentucky all the Estate to which I may be entitled (after my Just debts are discharged) both real and personal in the State of Virginia and North Carolina the Estate to which I have a claim in Virginia being an Interest in a tract of land lying in the County of Northumberland and is the sum of which my father George Vanlandingham late of said County and State died seized and possessed and contains about two hundred acres - the tract of land in North Carolina lying in the County of Rockingham containing and hundred acres by Patent bearing date the 15th day of June 1803. the residue of my Estate consisting of some spirituous liquors, Bonds & accounts which are uncollected - all of which I do hereby give and bequeath unto my said son Thomas Vanlandingham and to his heirs forever.

Lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint my worthy friend Captains Robert Munger of the County of Rockingham and State of North Carolina and Daniel Worsham of the County of Henry and State of Virginia Executors of this my

last will and Testament hereby making and annulling all and every will and testament by me heretofore made, declaring this and no other to be my last will and Testament In testimony whereof I have hereunto subscribed my name and caused my seal to be affixed this fifth day of October in the year of our Lord eight hundred and Eleven
