 Will that my negro girl Philis have liberty
 to make choice of a master among my sons
 and sons-in-law that be.
 Will that my property exclusive of what
 is given by Will be put to sale & credit
 by way of vendue and whereas the money
 arising from such sale with other debts
 due me can be collected and the men-
 tioned legacies made up that then the
 balance of my estate be equally divided
 between my sons and daughters.
 Appoint my son James Patrick and my
 son-in-law John Colvial to execute this
 my last Will and Testament. In all which
 presents I have made set my hand and seal
 this 12th day of March in the year of our
 Lord Eighteen and four

 in memory I constitute and make this my last
 Will and Testament. First of all after my just debts and funeral
 charges is paid I leave to my beloved wife Re-
 becca Roberts my land that I now live on
 during her natural life or widowhood After
 the decease of my Beloved wife or marriage
 my land to return to Josiah Steward all
 my personal estate excepting those which
 hereafter shall be mentioned leave to my
 beloved wife To my son Martin Roberts
 one heifer. To my daughter Sarah Brown
 one young hog. To my daughter Rachael Oliver
 one young hog. This I constitute my last will
 and testament. Signed Sealed this 17th March

In the name of God amen I Samuel
 Fielder of Rockingham County State of North
 Carolina Planter being through age and in-
 firmities weak in body, but of sound mind
 and memory blessed be God for it do make
 and declare this to be my last Will and
 testament in manner and form following
 VIZ: First and principally I commend my
 soul unto God who gave it, and by body to
 the earth to be buried in a Christian man-
 ner without any pomp in a firm belief of
 the resurrection thereof at the last day thro
 the mighty power of God, and do hope for
 free salvation for the sake of Jesus Christ
 and by his merits alone, and as for such
 worldly estate as God hath of his great
 mercy and goodness blessed me with I
 do dispose of in the following manner.
 First all my just debts and funeral charges
 to be paid. Second I give and bequeath unto

my beloved wife Hesiak the land & plantation
and appurtenances I now live on together
with one negro man named Peter, one
negro girl named Easter and her future
increase, one negro woman named Susannah
with all my stock of horses cattle sheep
and hogs and household furniture and
kitchen furniture except one feather Bed
and furniture to have and peaceably
enjoy during her lifetime or widowhood
then the above mentioned property to be
returned to my beloved son Samuel Fielder
with all and singular, to be his heirs or
assigns forever. Fourth I give and bequeath
unto my beloved son George Fielder one shilling
Fifth, I give and bequeath to my beloved
son William Fielder one shilling. Sixth
I give and bequeath unto my daughter
Susannah Neal one shilling. Seventh
I give and bequeath unto my daughter
Winny Hamlet one shilling. Eighth
I give and bequeath unto the heirs of my
daughter Elisabeth Park one shilling.
Ninth I give and bequeath unto my
Panny Waters one shilling. Tenth I give
and bequeath unto my daughter Xaney
one negro girl named Kate and her future
increase. Eleventh I give and bequeath
unto my daughter Panny, one feather Bed
and furniture and twenty dollars to be
paid to her by my Executors. Twelfth
I give and bequeath unto daughter Xaney
one shilling.
I do hereby constitute and appoint my
beloved wife Hesiak and my beloved son
Samuel Fielder Executors of this my last
Will and Testament and every particular
thereof. In Testimony whereof I have
hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal
this 11th day of June 1801

In the name of God amen This 20th
day of September one thousand eight hun-
dred and two I Andrew Martin of the County
of Rockingham and State of North Carolina
being in sound mind and memory & calling
to mind the mortality of my body, and
knowing that it is appointed for all men
once to die do make and Ordain this my
last Will and Testament in form I mane
following: That is to say I recommend
my Soul to God who gave it, and my body
to the dust to be buried in a christian
manner, at the discretion of my Executors
hereafter named, and as touching my
wordly estate wherewith it hath pleased
God to bless me with. I give & bequeath
in the following manner.
First my Will and desire is that all my
just debts be paid. Secondly, I will and
bequeath to my beloved wife Esther Martin all
my personal estate after paying my just debts
and after what is hereafter disposed to her
heirs or assigns together with the plantation and
its appurtenances whereon I now live during
her natural life with the tract of land to
keep the same up & in repair as she may
think proper.
