In the name of God amen I Thomas King son of Rockingham County and State of North Carolina being weak in body but sound in mind and memory thanke to the author of all good for the same and likewise knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die I do make this my last will and testament viz that is to say first of all I commit my soul to him that gave it likewise my body I commit to the dust from whence it came and to be buried in Christian burial

Secondly as to my real estate I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Sarah King her first choice of the stock of horses which I have and a good saddle and bridle and her first choice of the boxes and furniture which I have likewise her choice of the spinning wheels and then for her to have her choice of all the rest which I have and after my wife Sarah taking her choice do request that the balance be divided between all my child are equally without respect likewise I do appoint my son Lemiah King and William King as executors to this my last will and testament in witness where of I have set my hand and seal this 8th day of April 1803 Legally sealed and acknowledged in presence of

In the name of God amen
I Jamison Lamer in the County of Rockingham and State of North Carolina being of sound mind and understanding have thought proper to make this my last will and testament in manner and form following that is to say I recommend my soul to almighty God who gave me existence in this life and my body to a Christian Decent Burial at the discretion of my executors who I shall hereafter nominate and appoint first I will that all my Just debts be paid and discharged out of my estate
Secondly I give and bequeath to my loving wife Betsey Lamer my dwelling house with the buildings thereto attached as well as my Grist mill with its appurtenances thereto the boundaries to be comprehended by a line beginning at what was formerly called Raysouth east corner in the original tract thence beginning east with the narrow line until it strikes Brasher or Williams Line thence south crossing Troublesome creek thence west

After nearly so to include the aforesaid buildings and
Black Smiths shop and with a curving line leav-
ing it on the south side until we get near the meadow
Branch thence with a line to run from James Lancer
Spring to the mill dam and from thence to the begin-
ning including half that tract from this line east
together with my negro slaves John Aggy Samant
Isabell also two beds and furniture a set of tables
one cask and chest my Tom horse mowing rig and
all the geese and her choice of two cows one yoke of
oxen and cart all my stock of hogs ten head of
sheep the plantation tools and fifteen dollars
worth of ~~household~~ furniture and set of tin and brass
for the use of the family for and during the term
of her natural life and all that find my will is
that Ananias Jackson Lancer to have and enjoy the
same forever and my will further is that the balance
or south part of the tract or east end I give and
devise to my son Sampson together with the
profits of my saw mill between him and my son
Ananias Lancer until he the said Ananias shall
arrive at the age of twenty one years
all the balance of my Lomas will and devise to my
son Thomas Jane Permy and Betsey that is to
say I give to Thomas all the balance lying and
adjoining the aforesaid line on the south
side of Foublesome creek and adjoining James
Lancer and Ogburns line and so near the creek
as the high water mark of the mill pond and
all that part of my land lying on the north side
of said creek adjoining to the line running to Peep
corner and adjoining to Stones line and running
so near the creek as the high water mark of my

my mill pond together with my Bowen tract of three
hundred and thirty nine Acres and my Matthews tract
of one hundred Acres of Land I give and devise to my
three daughters Jane Permy and Betsey to be equ-
ally divided between them in quantity and qual-
ity my negroes Hannah Philch and eve I purport
for immediate sale all the balance of my negroes
which remain from those provided out my will
is to be equally divided between my sons and daugh-
ters namely Thomas Sampson Jane Permy
and Betsey and all the remaining balance of my
chattel property to be sold except the second yoke of
oxen which I give to my son Thomas as also my
large mare and harness apportioned these of
my sons agreeable to my judgement
David Lancer the sum of two thousand five hundred
and twenty five
Buckner Lancer the sum of eighteen hundred and
fifty dollars
Herting Lancer the sum of two thousand two hundred
and fifty dollars
Harland Lancer the sum of thirteen hundred and
fifty dollars
James Lancer the sum of thirteen hundred and fifty
and my will is that those heretofore apportioned if
any lack any thing under the apportion I share
make to the younger children namely Thomas
Sampson Jane Permy and Betsey
Ananias Lancer I have placed his interest with
his mother for my will and devise is that all
my children should have an equal distribution
of my estate having thus disposed of my property

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In the name of God Amen I Hugh Litch of the
County of Rockingham and State of North Carolina
being sound in mind and perfect memory do this
twenty second day of June Eighteen hundred and
twenty constitute and appoint this my last will
and testament in the following manner to wit
1st I desire that all my last debts to paid and my
body to be buried in a decent manner at the discre-
tion of my executors

2nd I bequeath unto my beloved wife her choice of
two cows out of my stock of cattle and also that she
have my mare and colt and also to have her choice
of three sheep out of my flock and to have her choi-
ces of hogs out of my stock what she may deem
sufficient for her meat together with as much
of the house hold and kitchen furniture as she may
desire to keep. I also will that all my books and wear-
ing apparel be left to the discretion of my beloved
wife

3rd I will unto my beloved son Amerson Litch
his horse bridle and saddle I also will him his
rifle gun with the equipments belonging thereto
I also will him one ~~cow~~ feather bed and furniture
Likewise I leave him one cow

4th I will unto my beloved daughter Fane Litch her
mare bridle and saddle one ~~loophole~~ and all the
appurtenances belonging thereto and all other property
that she may lawfully claim I over that all the
remainder of my ^{live} stock together with one horse and
such of my house hold and kitchen furniture as
my wife does not feel disposed to keep that it be
