hundred and thirteen I Sam^l Woodward of the
County of Rockingham and State of North
Carolina being weak in Body but in good and
perfect mind and memory thanks be to
almighty god calling to remembrance the
uncertain Estate of this transitory life and that
all flesh must yield unto death when it shall
please god to call do make constitute or ordain
and declare this my last will and testament

my will is that all my last debt first to be paid
by my Executors hereafter to be mentioned I give
to my dear and beloved wife Sally Woodward during
her life the balance of my negro land place
& Tanning after my debt is paid with my stock
of hog hattle and horse household and kitchen
furniture and all my working tools I give my
will is that after the death of my beloved wife that
the balance of the said negroes with the stock of
hog hattle and horse and household furniture
and kitchen furniture and working tools to be
set up at the highest bidder and sold at my exec
utors credit and the money to be divided in thirds
I give my will is that my son Edmond Woodward receive
two parts of the money and my son Arram Woodward
receive one part out of three of the money I
also ordain and appoint my worthy friends
Bra Ellis and Sterling Huffer my Executors to
thru my last will & testament sealed signed and
acknowledged in the presents of us
