In the name of God amen Sarah Mills do make
this my last will and testament perfect in mind but
not in health: I first wish my last acts paid
Item I give to Elizabetta Ellington one hundred dollars
Item I give to Susan Ellington one hundred dollars
Item I give to Martha Stubblefield one hundred dollars
Item I give to Mary Ingram the balance of my mo-
ney and property this money above mentioned is to be
paid out of a bond due me on my Brother Hugh
Mills. I also appoint brother Abner Mills brother
Stubblefield and William Gilliam all of the
County of Rockingham my executors signed sealed
This 6th day of April 1820.
